President's Message





Cantor's Corner



I wasn't always consistent about counting the Omer until recently in adulthood. I found that the best way for me to maintain the practice of counting down the days from Pesach to Shavuot was to build it into my nightly ritual. I have used a couple of different books

of poetry/meditation relating to the Omer (and the s'firot connected to their counting), so that I would look forward to uncovering a new perspective each night. Then, I found that beyond the meaning and personal pride I take in this practice, I would suddenly feel bereft after Shavuot has come and gone, with the counting over.

By this point, we're into the Torah book of Bamidbar, the recounting of our lengthy desert-dwelling days. We call this book 'Numbers' in English, because numbers and the counting of people factor heavily into this book. I've never been too keen on Mathematics, but I know there is significance in the way we count. Whether it's counting ten Jewish adults in a minyan, counting down the days to Shabbat or the minutes until three stars are seen in the night sky at its conclusion, or counting down from one holiday to the next. It's not just a recognition of the constant shift in our lives between the holy and the mundane, but it's also an awareness of how precious time is. Moreover, within the book of Numbers, our ancestors' roles were a part of how they were counted. What we do, how we act shapes how we count.

Though the counting of the Omer is concluded, I now find myself counting down the days to a significant milestone: my installation! It is incredibly meaningful to me that this community, my spiritual home, is taking this opportunity to officially install me as Cantor here. It will be especially momentous to have my mentor, Cantor Perryne Anker, who grew up at Temple on the Heights and has been a big part of my cantorial journey, here to install me. I hope to see you there June 9th/10th and may we all continue to make these precious moments in our lives count!


