# Beineinu - Between Us



Saying goodbye to my mother was one of the hardest things I have ever done, and also one of the most beautiful. My mother was lucid to the very end. She made the choice to have her vent removed rather than suffer from pain until her cancer would ultimately take her. It was no doubt not an easy decision for her to make. Nor was it easy for us to accept. But we knew it was right.

She had her entire family gathered around her. We all had the opportunity to tell her we love her, to assure her that we would take care of each other and to say goodbye. The room was filled with tears as we shared together in the words of the *vidui* (confessional prayer) ending in the *Shema*. We had the gift of knowing this was her wish, that she would no longer suffer, and that we could surround her in her final moments with love. We will hold on to our memories of her and the legacy she leaves behind. I know that God will watch over her and we will always feel her presence.

Losing my mother has given me a new, deeper appreciation for the wisdom and compassion of Conservative *Halakhah* (Jewish law) in permitting the withdrawal of life support when recovery is not possible and bringing an end to suffering. It also gave me a deeper understanding of the losses that so many of you have sustained over the years. It is one thing to teach or counsel someone who is bereaved, and quite different to experience it oneself. The pain of losing a parent is deep and searing. I only now am understanding fully not just the hurt and sense of loss, but also the anchorless feeling and the roller coaster of emotions, confusion and sadness that accompanies it.

Most of all, it has given me a renewed appreciation for the wisdom behind Jewish mourning practices and the comfort they bring, and for the power of community. I am so overwhelmed with gratitude to each and every one of you for the extraordinary outpouring of love and support both during my mom's struggle and especially after her passing. You have carried me and my family through this challenge in extraordinary ways, embracing us and holding us up, enabling us to go on. Thank you from the bottom of my heart.

# President's Message



Do you know why Passover is my favorite holiday? I will give you a hint: it comes down to one word...ENGAGEMENT. I can think of no other holiday when we are more engaged than Passover. Even otherwise non-observant Jews relish the Passover Seders when family and friends gather for a feast that is loaded with prayers, songs, traditions and storytelling. Better yet, the holiday is designed to engage people of all ages. Even the very youngest play critical roles from the *Ma Nishtana* to finding the *Afikoman*.

Of course, leading an engaging Seder can be a bit stressful. To help make it easier, below are some fun facts and traditions about the holiday that you can incorporate into your Seder. (Special thanks to the Heritage Florida Financial News, Chabad.org and beliefnet.com)

1. According to the 2014 Pew Portrait of American Jews, the Passover Seder is celebrated by even more Jewish people than Yom Kippur and Hanukkah.
2. The Haggadah is the most popular book in the history of Jewish printing, having gone through thousands of editions. The first American edition of the Haggadah was published in 1837.
3. The world's largest Passover Seder takes place in Nepal. The "Seder on Top of the World" in Kathmandu had about 2,000 attendants in 2018.
4. The world's largest matzah ball was made in New York City in 2009. Chef Anthony Sylvestry managed to make a matzah ball measuring 22.9" wide and weighing 267 lbs!
5. Jews from Iran and Afghanistan have a particularly lively custom in which they whip each other with oversize scallions. Many believe it is a way to mimic the whips of slave drivers in Egypt.
6. In the Polish town of Gora Kalwaria, Hasidic Jews mark Passover by re-enacting the crossing of the Red Sea. To make it as realistic as they can, they pour water on the floor, lift up their coats and recite the names of the towns they would cross.
7. During Passover, to commemorate their past and celebrate renewal, some Ethiopian Jews break all their dishes and cookware and make new ones. The tradition is in keeping with the hope for emancipation and redemption that the holiday signifies.

# From the Rabbi



In the course of our dramatic and engaging retelling of the Exodus at the Passover Seder, we break the middle matzah in half and hide it. Breaking the middle matzah for *yachatz* and hiding the *afikoman* teaches us that our world is broken and it is our mission to "repair the world," performing *tikkun olam*, to make our world a better place. We are reminded of the blessings in our lives that we have enough food to eat while many are struggling.

Most families have the adults or Seder leader hide the matzah and children search. Sometimes, it is searching for one large piece, while others break the matzah into as many pieces as there are children. In other homes, it is the children who hide the matzah and the adults search. A creative congregant shared with me that he designs a special house fixture, art piece or hardware out of matzah and then has the family search for it each year. Whoever finds the hidden matzah has great negotiating power since the Seder cannot end until the *afikoman* is eaten. Iraqi Jews tie the *afikoman* to the back of one of the children who has to stay awake and guard it, while the other children wait for the guardian to nod off to sleep and snatch it.

The search for the *afikoman* serves as a metaphor for each of us. We all have hidden parts that are waiting to be found. Passover celebrates freedom and wholeness. Before the holiday, our mission is to find *hametz* in our homes and buy *kosher l'pesach* products. We have an entire closet in our home dedicated to Passover, so this hidden closet is opened and its contents are revealed. Passover's inner search is a time to open up and find freedom with a new personal dimension.

The hide and seek game for the *afikoman* reminds us to search for what is missing in our lives. There are no guarantees we will find what we are looking for. And yet, sometimes just a bite of Passover dessert or a small piece of the dry, crumbling matzah can bring completion and satisfaction. May we each find the hidden treasures in our family and home this Passover.

## Teaching from our Shabbaton

We had a wonderful time at our "Shabbat on the Circle" congregational Shabbaton with nearly 100 of our community members celebrating a festive Shabbat together in University Circle. We enjoyed Shabbat meals, prayers, learning, time with friends, meeting new people and *havdallah* (followed by Mitchell's ice cream!) together. Throughout the Shabbaton, we learned about the nature of Jewish community in connection with the building of the *Mishkan*, the Tabernacle, which was discussed extensively in the week's Torah portion.

Among the learning at the Shabbaton was a teaching from the *Shaarei Orah*, a Kabbalistic text from the Middle Ages in Spain: The Torah describes 100 silver planks (*adnei kesef*) which are used in the building of the *Mishkan*. The text recognizes that the word in the Torah for these planks has the identical letters as the name of God, *Adonai*. Therefore, even though we don't have the physical 100 silver planks as the *Mishkan* described in the Torah, we can build our own spiritual *Mishkan* by replacing the 100 planks (*adanim*) with 100 blessings to *Adonai*. Just as the *Mishkan* was designed to be a portable spiritual space as it traveled with the Israelites in the wilderness, our blessings help us create a spiritual space for ourselves and our community.

I encourage you to take a moment to think about our community at B'nai Jeshurun. What blessings do you receive from our community? What blessings do you have to share with our community? With all of our blessings, let us continue to build our own *Mishkan*, ever-strengthening the wonderful community we have here.

Firstborns, normally required to fast the day before Pesach, are relieved of this requirement by attending a Torah study session (*Siyyum*) on the morning before the holiday. This year's *Siyyum* will be held on **Friday, April 19**, at the conclusion of the *Shaharit* service. **There will be just one minyan beginning at 7:00 am in Halpern Hall.**

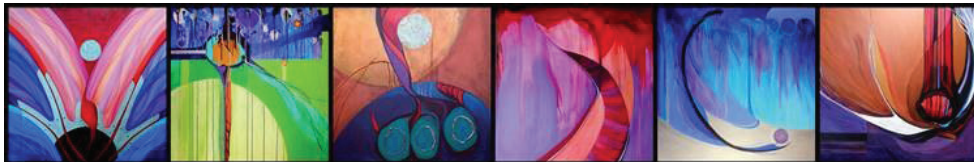

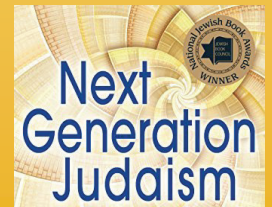
