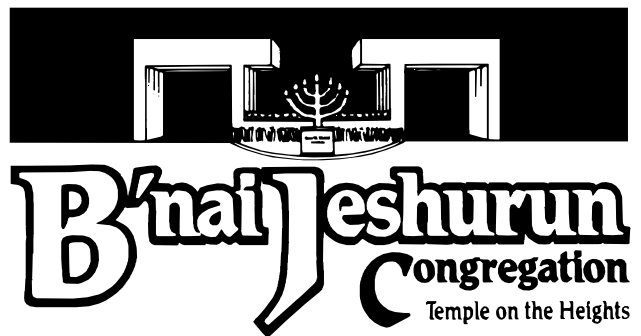

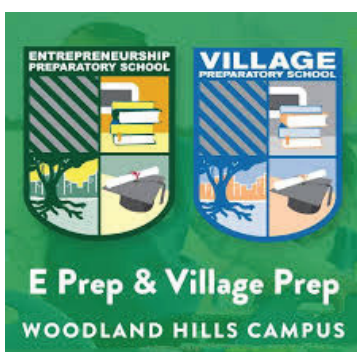
## Get the SCOOP about B'nai Jeshurun Sunday, August 12 • 6 – 8 pm

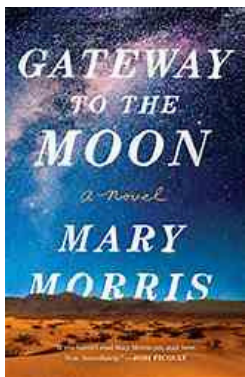
