Beineinu - Between Us



As we approach the month of Elul – in which we begin the process of *teshuvah* that culminates in Yom Kippur – I think of one of my favorite places in Israel: Rosh Hanikra. These magnificent grottos, on the northernmost coast of Israel, were carved out of limestone by the pounding of the waves over tens of thousands of years. The intricate lace of caves and tunnels goes deep into the rock, and is graced

on the outside by dramatic cliffs and unusual rock formations shaped by the water. Michelangelo used to say that he did not create his sculptures. They were hidden within his stone; he simply revealed them. In the same way, it always seemed to me that the beauty of Rosh Hanikra's grottos must have been hidden within the rock by God, waiting to be revealed by the water.

It is said that at the age of 40, Akiva had not studied a word of Torah. A shepherd by trade, no doubt he was intimidated by the sages of the academy. Then one day, Akiva was standing by the mouth of a well. He noticed that the water dripped out; and his gaze followed the drip to a bowl shaped stone. He wondered aloud: "Who hollowed out this stone?" "Akiva," he was told, "haven't you read [in the book of Job] that 'water wears away stone?' It is the constant drip of water, day after day, which created the hollow in the rock."

At that moment, Akiva came to a realization. "Is my mind harder than stone? I will go and study at least one section of Torah!" He went directly to the schoolhouse, where he began to read with his son. First the teacher wrote an *alef* and a *bet*, and he learned to read them. Like the dripping water, he worked his way through the entire Hebrew alphabet letter by letter. Then, he learned the book of Leviticus, and finally the entire Torah and the Oral Law. In the end, Akiva became one of the greatest sages there has ever been.

Transformation requires patient determination. What we need most is to be like Rabbi Akiva, to look at the well of Torah and ask ourselves, "Am I harder than stone?" Drip by drip, day by day, challenge by challenge, we can make ourselves over again, if we try. And as we change, like the grottos of Rosh Hanikra, the beauty that lies within becomes revealed.

Naomi joins me in wishing you a shana tova!

Cantor's Corner



This month will be the Hebrew month of Elul in which we begin to blow the shofar. The shofar is sounded in the daily morning minyan with the exception of Shabbat. It serves as a wake-up call from our spiritual slumber. As each day draws nearer to the Days of Awe, we need to act with a sense


of urgency. It is not optimum to enter into the High Holy Days without any modified behavior of the status quo. One should start the process of rectifying wrong doings against others. In addition to the engagement of our fellow man, we need to draw closer to G-d. It cannot just be lip service, but requires effort and actions. We need to attend more services and participate in prayer; give more charity and learn more Torah. In general, we need to become a difference maker individually and collectively.

We have to show G-d that although we have slipped and not lived up to expectations, we are remorseful and acknowledge our shortcomings. This process is known as teshuvah or repentance. It should be an ongoing process that requires constant focus and self-awareness. One has to be brutally honest and check one's ego at the door. This is the only way to achieve higher levels of productivity as a human being and Jew. No one wants to hear of their shortcomings and failures. However, those who are successful in the repentance process recognize this within themselves and are motivated to correct their actions.

The eerie sound of the shofar should penetrate our hearts. Our sages were aware that preparation prior to the High Holy Days is necessary to reach deep into inner selves to make these corrections in our flaws. Anyone who has run marathons does not just show up the day of the race. They prepare for several months, building up endurance and strength to have a successful outcome. Hopefully, our changes will be permanent, catapulting us into a new sphere with G-d and one another.

May all our prayers and efforts be accepted by G-d.

In the first parasha we read this month, Eikev, we are commanded to walk in God's ways - but what does it really mean to walk in God's ways? What attributes and qualities demand our reverence, our action? Moses could mention any number of qualities or feats when describing God's

attributes to the Israelites. Perhaps he could remind B'nai Yisrael of God's might in afflicting the Egyptians with the ten plagues, or in splitting the Red Sea, perhaps in recounting the Flood or the Tower of Babel. But instead, Moses tells the people that God "shows no favor and takes no bribe, but upholds the cause of the fatherless and the widow and befriends the stranger, providing them with food and clothing" (Deut. 10:17-18).

We learn here from Moses that walking in God's ways is not about our might but rather about our love and care for those in need, those afflicted by injustice, and those in suffering. Tzedakah, advocacy, service, lending a helping hand - these are God's ways.

This year, B'nai Jeshurun teens will have the opportunity to travel and help a community suffering from the effects of natural disaster, as well as helping strengthen our community through our service. As our teens demonstrate walking in God's ways as described in Parashat Eikev, let us all heed the call to make a difference in our world. There is so much that can be done, all over the world and right here in our own community, and there is never a better time to take action than right now.



We thank Theresa & Lee for all they do to support our congregation.


