GCC: A Thousand-Person Criminal Justice Action
Thursday, February 27 • 7 pm • Olivet Institutional Baptist Church

The goal of this Action is to secure one or more off-site, pre-booking Mental Health and Addiction Diversion Centers in Cuyahoga County, giving police an alternative to jail for persons suffering a mental health or addiction crisis. Research clearly demonstrates their effectiveness. Diversion centers in Cleveland will save lives and public money while also reducing overcrowding in our County jail and help to level the judicial field for people of color. BJC has pledged to bring at least 50 people to the Action.
