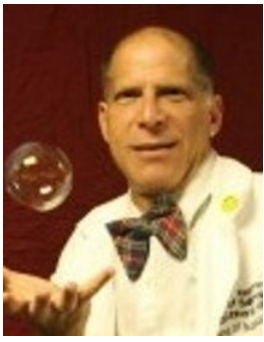

Mr. Sztokman will discuss his organization, which is a grassroots response to poverty, malnutrition, ill health, hunger and child labor in India.

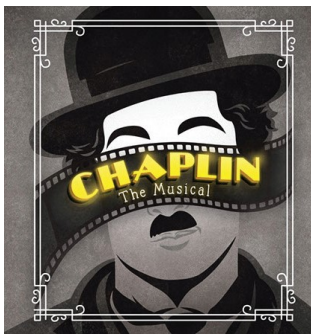

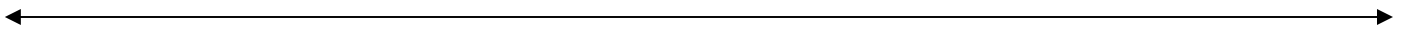
