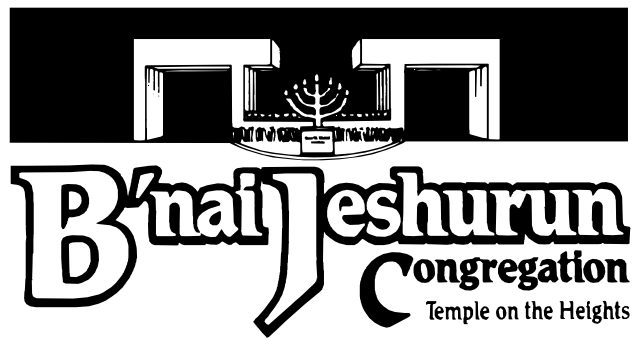

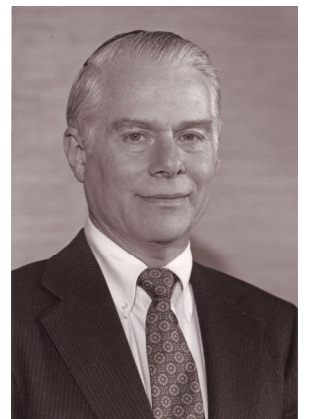

Sort and pack food that will go to Jewish families in need. Everyone volunteering should be over the age of 7. Contact Shani Kadis if you would like to help.

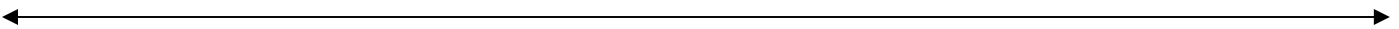

As a teen, Mrs. Worley took action to try and save her school, Martin Luther King, Jr. Law and Public Service, which was on the verge of being closed down while the city was in an uproar over the Cleveland Browns leaving. She left Cleveland because she felt her childhood neighborhood of Central in the late 80's had changed from a safe space into a war zone.



But, when she came back, she met with leaders and realized that GCC was bringing together people who truly wanted to fight for this city. They wanted to prevent other 14 year-olds like her who were already planning their exit route. She will share with us her incredible story of how she has been able to help youth and how her high school experience helped her become a powerful woman and a force to be reckoned with!

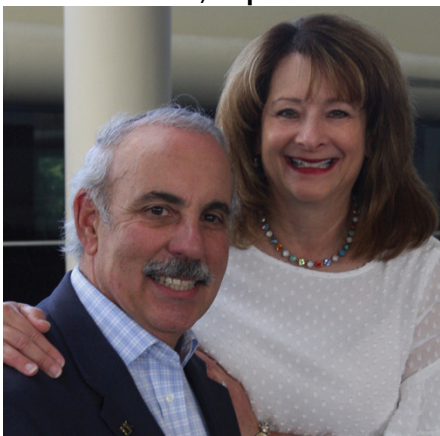
