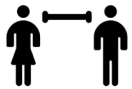




# 2020-2021 HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS



## LIMITED PERSONAL CONTACTS

- Each class will be a defined “bubble” with students and two teachers.
- Bubbles are together the entire school day.
- Class size limit determined by CDC requirements.



## HYGIENE

- Children wash hands upon arrival to classroom, before eating, and after outdoor play.
- Children use classroom bathroom only.
- Teachers promote healthy hygiene habits for sneezing, washing, etc.



## OUTDOOR & INDOOR PLAY SPACES

- In addition to their classroom, a class will have a dedicated indoor AND outdoor play space.
- Outdoor play encouraged frequently.



## FACE MASKS

- Teachers wear face masks at all times. Breaks allowed during outdoor play, but easily accessible if close contact with a child.
- Students required to wear face masks in the parking lot and hallways until their classroom is reached.
- Student face mask wear is encouraged in classroom, as much as reasonably possible. Not required for nap or lunch time.
- Adults required to wear face masks for drop off and pick up at all times.



## VISITORS

- No family members or guests will be allowed in the school building.
- We know family experiences matter! Virtual opportunities to connect for “Shabbat Family” and other interactions will be created.



## ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

- Each class has its own designated entrance and exit to the building.
- School day staggered 15 minute start and end times to limit contact between classes.
- Care givers will meet teachers at building entrance.



## CLEANING & SANITATION

- High touch surfaces cleaned throughout the day by building maintenance when children leave the classroom and at the end of the school day.
- Teachers will wipe down tables and counters before eating and at the end of the school day.
- “Dirty toy” bin to be used for items that have gone in students’ mouths.
- Teachers will wear gloves, as always, when changing diapers.



## DAILY SCREENING

- All children screened for fever with contactless thermometer and undergo visual inspection of health.
- Any child with fever of 100.0 degrees or higher will not be allowed into the school building until doctor’s note is received.



## RESPONDING TO POSITIVE CASES

- Parents will be notified if any student in class is tested for COVID-19.
- In the event of a confirmed COVID-19 case, individual “bubbles” will self-quarantine, but not the entire school.



## SHARING

- Sharing of materials and toys will be limited to individual classes only.
- Personal items, such as sheets and pillows for naps, will not be shared and sent home weekly for cleaning.
