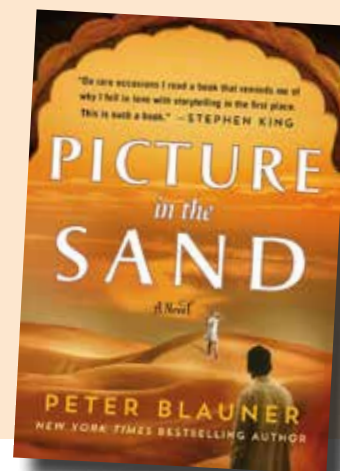

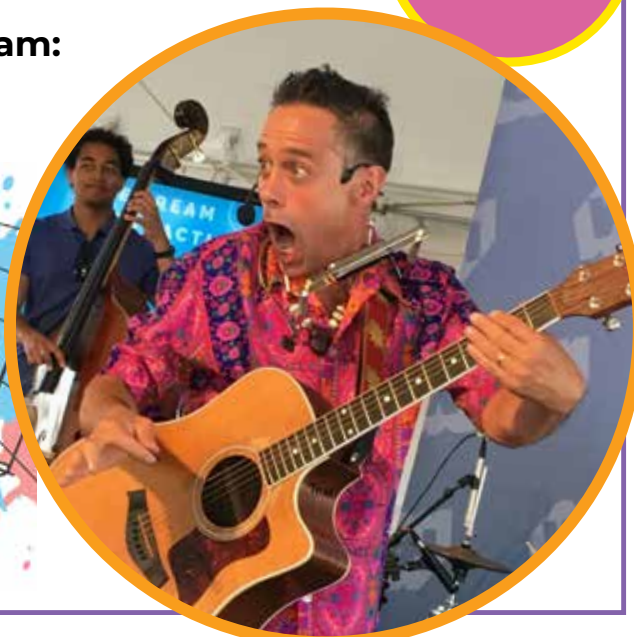

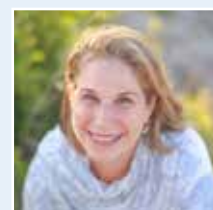

## Bookplates

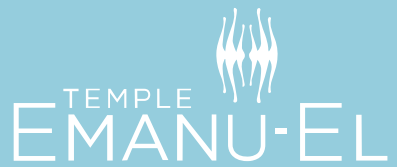
