by Dublin Artist David Goldberg

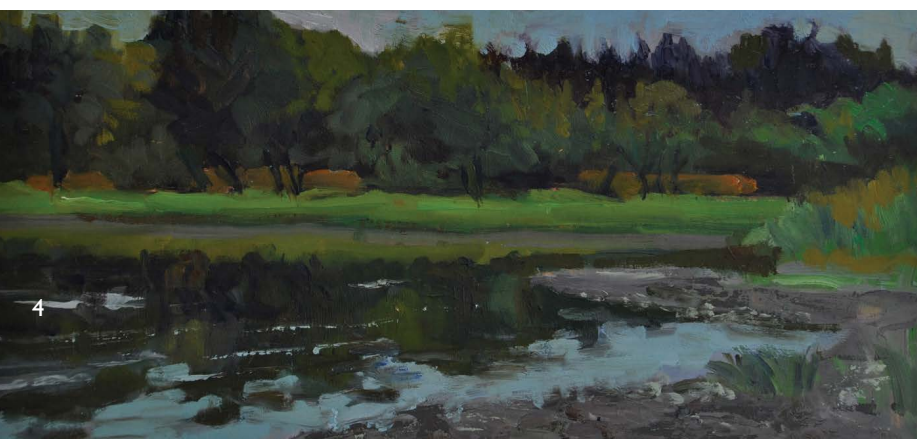
in conversation with artist Colin Watson, RUA

David Goldberg was raised in Cork, Ireland, and was inspired from an early age to pursue his passion for painting. He has won acclaim for his landscape and still life painting, and for his poetry. David has exhibited regularly with the Royal Hibernian Academy, Dublin, the Royal Ulster Academy, Belfast, and at many society exhibitions at the Mall Galleries, London. David will show viewers a virtual exhibition of his works live from his studio in Dublin. The visit will be conducted in conversation with noted Belfast artist, **Colin Watson, RUA**, with whom David travelled and painted in Morocco in 2019. Goldberg's work on display in his studio includes paintings of Jerusalem, Morocco, Ireland, South Africa, and a series of shadows and flowers.

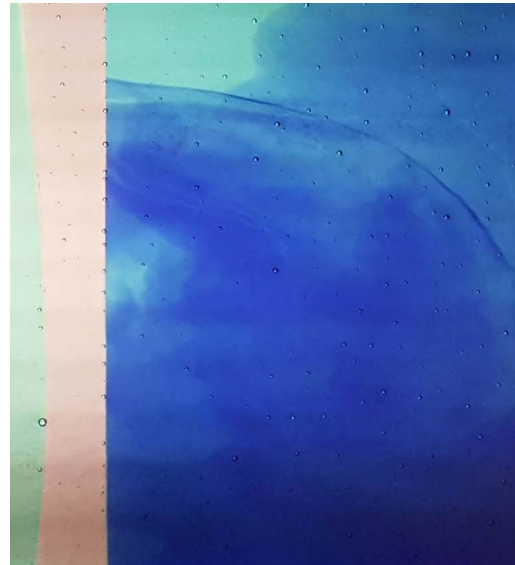
