David Goldberg was raised in Cork, Ireland, and was inspired from an early age to pursue his passion for painting. He has won acclaim for his landscape and still life painting, and for his poetry. David has exhibited regularly with the Royal Hibernian Academy, Dublin, the Royal Ulster Academy, Belfast, and at many society exhibitions at the Mall Galleries, London. David will show viewers a virtual exhibition of his works live from his studio in Dublin. 


