Refugee Resettlement

The Welcome the Stranger interfaith partnership of Old North Church, Temple Emanu-El and St. Andrew Episcopal Church are continuing the work resettling refugee families in conjunction with Catholic Charities. Last month we moved a family into a new apartment and expect many more arrivals shortly.

We are using a portion of the Kraus family's mini grant through the Union of Reform Judaism to pay for recent court filing fees to bring Danie's daughter, Djahimara, to Marblehead. We are also using the Kraus grant money for refugee moving expenses.

Due to Covid-19 our volunteer assistance for My Brother's Table and the MA Coalition for the Homeless (A Bed for Every Child Program) is on hold.



In The Color of Water, McBride retraces his mother's footsteps and, through her searing and spirited voice, recreates her remarkable story.

The daughter of a failed itinerant Orthodox rabbi, she was born Rachel Shilsky (actually Ruchel Dwara Zylska) in Poland on April 1, 1921. Fleeing pogroms, her family emigrated to America and ultimately settled in Suffolk, Virginia, a small town where anti-semitism and racial tensions ran high.


