Refugee Resettlement

The Welcome the Stranger interfaith partnership of Old North Church, Temple Emanu-El and St. Andrew Episcopal Church are continuing the work resettling refugee families in conjunction with Catholic Charities. Last month we moved a family into a new apartment and expect many more arrivals shortly.

We are using a portion of the Kraus family's mini grant through the Union of Reform Judaism to pay for recent court filing fees to bring Danie's daughter, Djahimara, to Marblehead. We are also using the Kraus grant money for refugee moving expenses.

Due to Covid-19 our volunteer assistance for My Brother's Table and the MA Coalition for the Homeless (A Bed for Every Child Program) is on hold.



Meal Deliveries

Thanks to all who contributed their time and energy to delivering over 1,500 meals to food-insecure, low-income families. We worked with Christopher's Cafe in Lynn in conjunction with the Mass Coalition for the Homeless.

Christopher's Cafe has been preparing and delivering meals to food insecure low-income families throughout the pandemic.



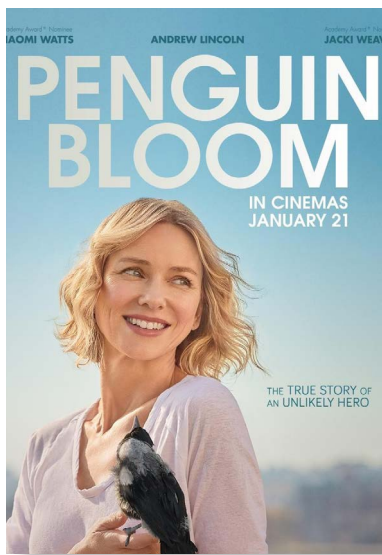
