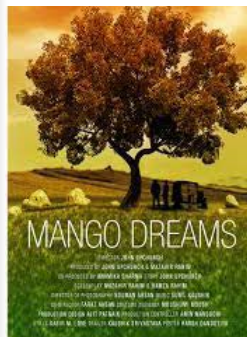


First Wednesday of every month. Watch the movie on Netflix or Amazon Prime, and then join us on Zoom for a discussion.

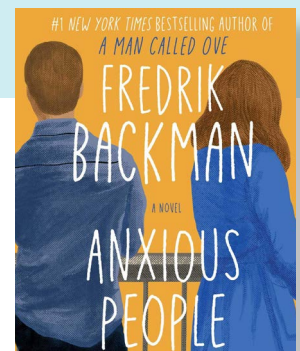

Memorial Park

Not everyone knows that Temple Emanu-El has a Memorial Park in Danvers.

It is the burial ground of many of our loved ones and many more of us have secured plots to use ourselves in the future.

In recent years the Memorial Park has fallen into conditions other than our expectation for our sacred space. We are delighted to announce the formation of the Memorial Park Task Force to immediately restore our cemetery to our standards and to address our needs going forward.

Prior to our Memorial Service for the High Holydays, we were able to complete an overhaul of the landscaping at the graves, entranceway, and Meditation Garden. The pathway and Meditation Garden pavers were power washed and the Rock Boxes were repainted and stocked with new visitation stones.

Over the coming months, we will be working on signage, design plans to upgrade the entrance and Meditation Garden, review the condition of the markers, and explore expansion plans. Additionally, we will address the deferred maintenance including repaving the road around the cemetery.

We are very pleased to be involved with this meaningful work and grateful to those on the Task Force for their creativity, time and efforts.

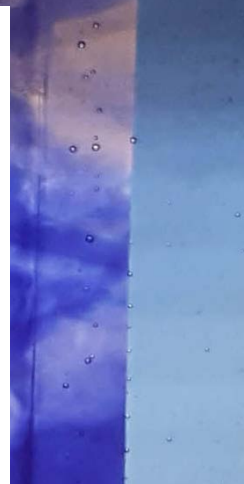
