Meetings are taking place outside in the parking lot to the left of the building as you enter from Atlantic Avenue. In the event of inclement weather, we will meet inside the Temple.



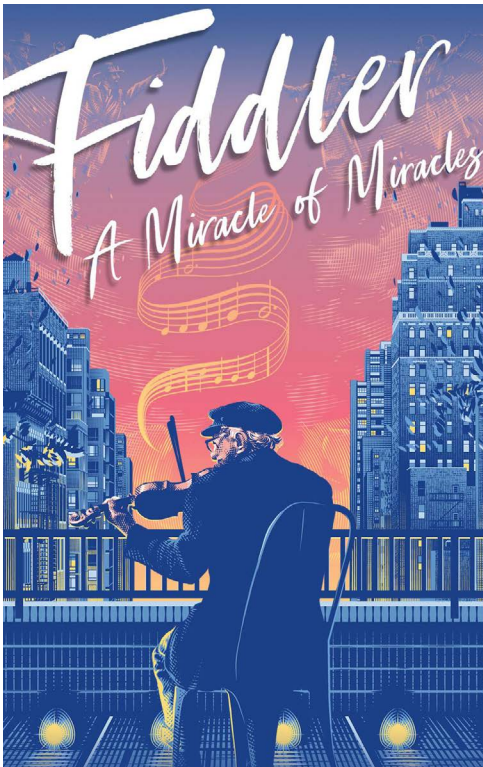

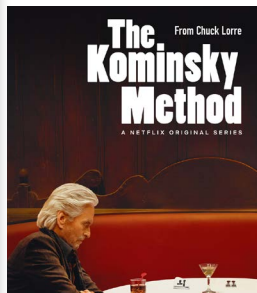
Movie Night:

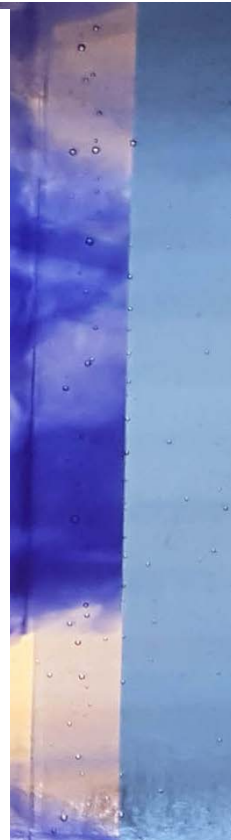
