


Compost Coordinator Duties at Events

Temple Isaiah is composting! We've been composting for a year and rely on everyone to help us out. If you are "on duty" as compost coordinator for a community dinner or other large event, here are some tasks to make it easier for everyone to compost their food waste.

- **Arrive 20 minutes prior to the event**
- **Set up a "Compost Corner"** (that will include receptacles for compost, trash, liquids, and recyclables)
 - **Compost:** Place 2 garbage cans lined with a heavy-duty plastic bag then with a large green compost bag. The plastic bag stays in the bin — it does not go out with the compost — it is there to keep the garbage can clean. Tape onto each can a sign that reads "compost."
 - **Trash:** Place 2 garbage cans lined with just a heavy-duty plastic bag a few feet away, each can will need a taped sign that reads "trash"
 - **Liquids:** Put out a container to collect liquid waste. If the event is small use the plastic water pitchers. Otherwise, on a top shelf in the storage area are 2 very large empty water cooler size containers and funnels.
 - **Recyclable:** Recycle bin
- **Place Signage:** There are laminated signs that can be taped to the wall by each garbage can, or you can tape actual items to the wall over each can if you prefer. Blue tape works best.
 - There are 4 signs — Compost, Trash, Recycle, Liquid Waste — signs are in the hanging cabinet to the right of the main sink and should be returned to that location at end of event. PLEASE DO NOT THROW THESE OUT
 - There are table top tents reminding people that "Temple Isaiah composts," you can place on the table if you chose
- **After the event:** If possible, at the end of the meal hang around the compost area and help people toss things into the correct bin. Please note: that *the tablecloths are not compostable and should be the only things that go into the trash.*
