

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The California Healthy Schools Act of 2000 is a right-to-know law that provides parents with information on pesticide use on school campuses. It requires that all child care centers and schools provide parents/guardians with annual written notification of expected pesticide use on school sites.

We expect to use the following pesticides in our school this year:

Name of Pesticide (Common Name)	Active Ingredient(s)
Orange Guard Inc.	d-Limonene
Monterey Ant Control	Iron phosphate, spinosad
Roundup Weed Killer	Glyphosate, isopropylamine salt

In addition, parents/guardians may request to be on a registry to receive prior notification of individual pesticide applications at our school. People listed on the registry will be notified at least 72 hours before pesticides are applied. If you would like to be notified of pesticide applications, please contact the office to be placed on the registry.
