*Sibling must go home

*Regardless of vaccination status. Close contact is less than 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer.











Return to school with receipt of **negative PCR** test taken 5 days from last contact, unless symptoms develop.

NO EXPOSURE, BUT SYMPTOMATIC?

Participation of students in program is always at the discretion of the teachers and administrators. In order to protect all children and staff members, any child who has symptoms severe enough that he or she is unable to participate fully in program and/or who requires one on one care will be excused from program until he or she is well enough to return.





fever and symptoms nearing resolution. A doctor's note is required.



If student receives a negative PCR or lab-based rapid antigen test, return to school 24 hours after symptoms nearing resolution without medication.



If student receives a positive PCR test or no provider visit or test, return to school only after 10 days since symptom onset and 24 hours without fever. Quarantine close contacts of confirmed cases.
