2022 - 2023 COVID DECISION TREE

Revised March 21, 2023

Participation of students in program is always at the discretion of the teachers and administrators. In order to protect all children and staff members, any child who has symptoms severe enough that they are unable to participate fully in program and/or who requires one-on-one care will be excused from program until they are well enough to return.

Student/Staff has NEW symptom of illness including:
congestion, runny nose, sore throat, nausea, vomiting/diarrhea, fever
over 100.4 F, cough, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell.

Exclude from school

Recommend test for COVID-19.
(May use PCR or at-home rapid
antigen test.)

Positive

May return to school 5 full days after the start of
symptoms/initial positive test AND fever-free for 24
hours without the use of medication AND all other
symptoms have improved so that they can participate
fully in the classroom.

Positive students/staff returning in less than 10 days
from positive test must wear a KN95 mask or equivalent
until they have 2 sequential negative tests taken at
least 1 day apart.

Negative

May return to school if fever-free,
vomit-free, and diarrhea-free for 24
hours without the use of medication
AND symptoms have improved
significantly.
