Mandatory Requirements:

1. Attend ALL minyanim- weekdays, Shabbat & holidays**
2. Participate in all Shul events i.e. High Holidays, Community Dinners etc.
3. Live in Berwick within the Eruv
4. 3-Year Commitment
5. Ambassadors of Good Will- Spread the word about Beth Jacob and Berwick in the broader community
6. Join the Shul as paying member after one year

Eligibility:

1. Young Family- To be considered for our program couple must be married and under 35 years old.
2. Orthodox- To be considered for our program spouses must be Orthodox in belief and practice. Specifically, spouses must observe Shabbat, Kashrut & Taharat Hamishpacha.
