- 2. Recording Request Granted
- Rabbi Mates-Muchin Thoughts on Sabbatical
 - 1. Meditation was meaningful (art) and shared with WTS retreat
 - 2. Writing for 10 Minutes of Torah by women to recognize 1st female rabbi. Will share her in the bulletin
 - 3. Explored staffing models and strategic planning
 - 1. Needs constant experimentation
 - 2. Meet people where you are

- 6. Action and Discussion Bimah and Usher sign-up
 - 1. An updated Bimah Honor Guide document needs to be created
- 7. Information Financial report Lori Waltzer (20 min)
 - 1. Budget presentation
 - 1. Expenses are on track for the current fiscal year

- 2. Mortgage declining
- 3. No LOC balance
- 4. Cap Needs discussion with bank continuing
- 5. Cash flow is healthy and stable for the end of the year
- 6. Endowment growth is key
- 7. Membership dues at previously approved levels
- 2. Budget presentation
 - 1. Membership Contributions: Holding current membership levels and increased dues 5%to 2.494 MM (9.5% increase over the last budget)
 - 2. Pre-School 4% increase in tuition revenue
 - 3. RS and Youth: RS 6% increase
 - 4. Fundraising is typical with some lift from RMM's 18th year (\$145K)
 - 1. Legacy gifts are not included the budget for the new fiscal year
- 3. Expenses
 - 1. 5% increase in staff cost
 - 2. HHS at Paramount
 - 3. Facilities & G&A budgeted for in-person services
 - 4. Debt ongoing payments of \$12K/month
 - 5. Cap Expenditures
 - Not included in the budget due to unknowns, but we know we will have costs. Board will review Cap Ex budget later. Not usually included in the Operating Budget.
 - 6. Budgeting aligns with the previous Fiscal year
 - 1. Conservative estimate on fundraising
- 4. Board members should review and get back to Lori or Jon. This is a primary responsibility of the Board! Don't be shy!
- Action Welcome Forward recommendations (15 min) Steve Shane Guest Presenter from Welcome Forward
 - 1. Lift outdoor masking requirement
 - 2. Remain masked while in the building
 - 3. Stop checking vaccine status at the door
 - 4. Clergy to mask when in social situations, in close spaces, and where people cannot distance
 - 5. Kiddush and oneg
 - 1. Will either remain being served or family-style on tables can be considered
 - 2. We will continue to provide outdoor seating options
 - 3. Release requirement of being seated while eating
 - 6. The preschool, religious school, and youth program will continue to be masked while indoors
 - 7. Testing for Bnei Mitzvah students and their families is not required
 - 8. Anyone on the Bimah may be unmasked, including musicians who do not have to be behind a barrier
 - 9. Messaging going out to the community this week

 - 1. Focus groups with 10 families at a time
 - 2. Follow-up survey
 - 1. Recommendations
 - 1. Schedule: Move all K-6 to Sunday mornings, Sep to May
 - 1. 2 or 3 Sunday sessions
 - 2. 5 Family Shabbat experiences
 - Option for those who cannot attend weekend sessions (URJ shalom linked online program) with 3 weeknight family sessions.
 - 2. Connection:
 - 1. More family sessions in lieu of Sunday sessions
 - 2. Invite parents to experiences
 - 3. Small groups Kesher and Buddy system) to connect more
 - 3. Communications
 - 1. Monthly newsletters with blurbs from each grade
 - 2. At-home engagement with what kids are studying
 - 4. Outcomes
 - 1. Jewish identity formation
 - 2. Experiencing Judaism
 - 3. Making friends
