7. Information- Financial report – Lori Waltzer

- 12/31 half year point of fiscal year
 - Membership 96.5% to date of budget

- Revenue for membership at \$2.4M (compared to last year about \$29k higher)
- Took in more membership revenue than last year, but behind in budget
- School and youth revenue is about 96% to date of budget
- Overall about \$166k below budget (for membership and school revenue)
- Fundraising- at \$125k, at about 50% of fundraising goal for the year
- Bnei Mitzvah Fees is being reported as \$11k within the \$50k budget (Terrie is investigating)
- New mortgage passed under congregational vote- passed for \$3.6M of debt (NTE)- we will refinance existing debt, then repair dome and HVAC
- Terrie and Lori will reforecast where we are for this year, need to reconcile some expenses we haven't spent.

2023 Budget Setting

- 1. March- Lori and Terrie will use our financial status to set budget for next fiscal year
- 2. April- Lori will come to board to discuss revenue assumptions
- 3. May-Lori will present budget at the board meeting
- 4. June- board will vote on budget

Construction Budget

- 5. We will receive dome budget from finance committee on 1/19
- 6. Dome approved up to \$1.6M to repair dome
- 7. We are an Oakland Landmark, but not a state or national landmark, so no landmark restoration funding to apply for
- 8. We have the permit for the work on the dome
- 9. Need to look at Seismic report when we receive it in 2 weeks, as well to determine needs and costs. Capital Needs Task Force has a list of projects, process. There are upgrades that are needed to make sanctuary safer, but everything is compliant and up to code. Board can wait until the committee report and recommendations come to the board to review.

- There are lots of Rabbi Educator positions posted right now (about 80 which is high)
- Jobs are filled on a rolling basis (no deadline)
- Rabbi Freedman is working on a transition plan and documentation to support, as well as training Dalya for a smooth transition

- We are getting a quote for the other parts of the roof to ensure it doesn't leak
- Signed contract with GC- Oliver and Company
- Seismic study will be reviewed in the coming weeks.
- Annual inspection today and good news, the boiler will last this winter
