Solace and Solidarity

By requiring that the Kaddish be recited with a Minyan, our tradition rendered a profound service. A Minyan will usually include other mourners. The mourner is not a lonely traveler in the valley of the shadow. Other people are also making the heavy pilgrimage.

The Kaddish joins us to our people. It adjusts our perspective. It fortifies our faith. It reassures us with a promise of inner peace. It summons us to labor for a better world.

Lighting a Yahrzeit candle the evening before the Yahrzeit
and each date of Yizkor

Making a donation in their memory

Studying a Jewish text in honor of your loved one

Performing an extra act of *chesed*, loving kindness, in your
loved one's honor

Temple Israel sends notification by mail to all our members as a yahrzeit date nears. Please be sure the administration office is updated with names and dates for those you wish to honor.

In memory of your departed loved ones, Temple Israel has available the following remembrance opportunities:

- An individual bronze plaque inscribed with the name and date of death, both in English and Hebrew, mounted on a memorial tablet in the small sanctuary (Beit Midrash). A memorial plaque serves as a tribute to the memory of your loved one and helps support the congregation.
- During the Shabbat afternoon service preceding the *yahrzeit*, the *El Maleh Rachamim* prayer is recited by Temple Israel clergy for the deceased who have been so memorialized.
- Our congregation conducts daily morning and evening services where one may recite *Kaddish* and be supported by fellow congregants through the mourning period and on the *yahrzeit*.
- The names of those memorialized with a plaque are listed in the monthly Temple Israel Bulletin and weekly Shabbat Sheet.
