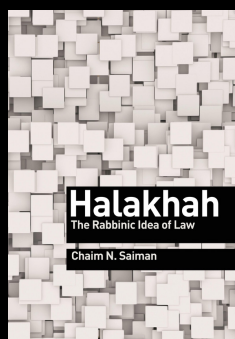

Chaim Saiman, a native Atlantan, is a scholar of Jewish law, insurance law and private law at Villanova University, and has just published *Halakhah: The Rabbinic Idea of Law* with Princeton University Press. Chaim has been the Gruss Visiting Professor of Talmudic Law at both Harvard Law School and the University of Pennsylvania Law School, a visiting fellow at Princeton University and a visiting professor at the University of Toronto, Bar-Ilan, Hebrew University and IDC faculties of law. Chaim also serves as dayyan on the Beth Din of America, and as an expert witness in insurance law and Jewish law in federal court.
