



Who is EHAP?

The Emergency Housing Program was started under the auspices of the Freehold Clergy Association (FCA) over a decade ago in response to the homeless crisis in our area. Over the years, an advocacy component was added to the program as the needs of our community continued to grow. With a blessing from the FCA, we have established ourselves as a 501(c)-3 private nonprofit. With our year round advocacy office in Freehold we are better positioned to serve the community.

What do we do?

Currently we have a handful of area congregations hosting up to twelve men per night from December through March. Volunteers from each hosting congregation provide a hot dinner, a nourishing breakfast and a warm place to sleep. Our licensed social worker provides free advocacy services to these participants as well as other men and women who are seeking assistance. These advocacy services include job assistance, housing, transportation, referrals for medical, dental, mental health and other resources as needed. Imagine how complicated something as simple as replacing an official ID can be for someone without access to these services.
