High Holy Day Tickets will be mailed to your home prior to the Rosh Hashanah. Photo ID, which matches the name on your TSE Member Pass, will be required for admission to all services. The Member Service Pass will not be available for pick-up at the Temple.

#### **Tickets**

Tickets will be mailed in time for High Holy Days to all members in good standing. Tickets (or your TSE Member Pass) will be accepted at either the early or late service. You will automatically receive the correct number of adult, child (13 years old and up) and family tickets, provided your dues are paid in full through September.

## Guest Tickets -Please use Guest Ticket Request Form enclosed

High Holy Day tickets will be available for purchase by Temple members for their children and parents who are not members of Temple Shaari Emeth. In addition, tickets will be available for purchase by Temple members for their brothers and sisters who reside outside of the Temple geographic area. A Temple family in good standing may purchase up to five (5) guest tickets for the High Holy Days.

The cost for guest tickets, per person, is \$75.00 for Rosh Hashanah Services and \$75.00 for Yom Kippur Services. Temple Shaari Emeth B'nai Mitzvah and Confirmands age 25 and over, whose parents are current members in good standing of Temple Shaari Emeth, may purchase High Holy Day guest tickets for \$50.00 per ticket, per holiday.

### **Reciprocal Tickets**

Any Temple member in good standing, college student or military personnel, who are members of the Temple and away from home, are entitled to attend High Holy Day Services at any URJ Congregation. Contact the Temple office for the necessary forms.
