Yuli Wexler was born in Moscow in 1947 to a secular Jewish family.

In 1972, in the early days of the Soviet Jewish emigration movement, he applied for an exit visa and was promptly denied permission to leave the USSR "for

reasons of state security.” For the next two years, Yuli was active in the “refusenik” community, passing information about the refuseniks’ plight to Jewish communities in the West through Western journalists, diplomats and tourists.

In 1974 he emigrated to the United States with the help of HIAS (Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society).

After retirement, Yuli joined the board of directors of HIAS, serving at a time when the HIAS mission expanded to include assistance to refugees of all faiths all over the world. [View his full bio here.](#)

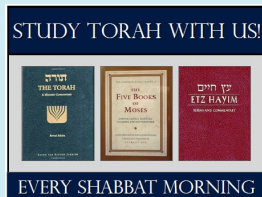

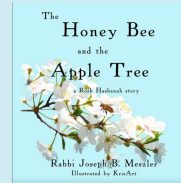
Membership & Engagement Committee Meeting (Zoom) Monday, November 1 | 7:00 PM

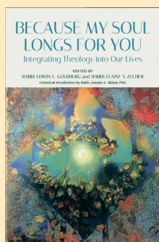
