The Gan at Temple Sinai

The word is out! When one asks, “Which preschool is *THE* best preschool in Sarasota?” the reply is a resounding, “The Gan at Temple Sinai.” This answer results from a carefully crafted plan to have the best program, facility and staff. Also, there are unrivaled opportunities for parents and children to become part of a community that is family-centric, warm and inviting while emphasizing the development of the whole child, a love of school and a love of learning.



At the core of our program is the dedicated staff. The fantastic team of teachers is experienced in early childhood education and devoted to making these young children’s preschool journey a positive first step in their education. This is done by implementing lessons that develop all areas of the curriculum from math and language to social and emotional skills.



Our beautiful facility allows for in-class activities and lessons, as well as “around-the-building” field trips. Every week the children visit various locations in the synagogue for activities: the synagogue’s library for story time with Geveret Laura, the science lab for experimenting and discovery while wearing their lab coats and goggles, the teaching garden to tend to their class’s bed of seedlings they have planted, the outdoor classroom, the school kitchen to measure and mix and cook recipes and of course, the two playgrounds for recess!



We gather each Monday and Friday in the sanctuary as one big Gan family to welcome the new week for Havdalah and to prepare to welcome Shabbat on Fridays. Blessings and songs are sung with a different student host every week to help lead on the bimah.

Temple Sinai is proud of our stellar, nationally accredited program that is a special part of our community.

NOVEMBER MEETING

Minutes Highlights

Barbara Pollack VP of Ritual: The Erev Shabbat Welcome Receptions are a way for members to communicate and schmooze and an opportunity to bring in new members. We are now scheduled for Welcome Receptions twice per month. We need volunteers and a committee to organize a process, get the food, set up and clean up.

Bethany Leinweber, Director of Youth Education and Family Engagement: Hands on Hanukkah is a massive outreach program for us, which took place from December 18 through December 23 at various locations around town, culminating with a dinner and concert by the Sarasota Chorale at Temple Sinai on Friday, December 23.

Bethany Leinweber, Director of Youth Education and Family Engagement: The Scholar-in-Residence program was cut from the budget. Instead we are having an Artist-in-Residence program featuring Jacob “Spike” Kraus the weekend of March 24-26, 2023. Spike performs shows for kids and adults. The weekend will start with an Erev Shabbat service. Saturday night there will be a concert with food trucks, desserts and drinks. Sunday there will be an interactive concert with Spike and teen musicians from Temple Sinai. All events will be open to the public, but some require registration and not all are free.

Andrea Eiffert, Director of Communications and Programming: Amy-Jill Levine will speak at our Erev Shabbat Service on February 24, 2023. Dr. Levine is the University Professor of New Testament and Jewish Studies, Mary Jane Werthan Professor of Jewish Studies, and Professor of New Testament Studies at Vanderbilt Divinity School, Graduate Department of Religion and Department of Jewish Studies. We are partnering with the Church of the Palms on this program and Dr. Levine will speak there on Saturday afternoon. Members of both congregations are encouraged to attend both presentations.

Chazzan Abramson: The Sinai Winter Music Program will bring cultural events to Temple Sinai between January and April. There will be four performances and Chazzan Abramson is underwriting the program. The program will be free for members and \$36 per performance, or \$99 for the series, for non-members.
