Dear OE Members and Friends,

I hope this message finds you and yours well.

This year we will again make available to you two options to appoint me your agent to sell your chometz.

Option one:

In person, employing the time-honored enhancement of in-person Kabalas Kinyan. I will be available to meet you in Shul at the following times:

- After the Sunday 6:30 am minyan and after the 8:00 am minyan until approximately 9:30 am.;
- After the weekday 7:10/20 am minyan, until 9:00 am;
- 1/2 hour before and after mincha / maariv throughout the week; or by appointment.

Option two:

As we did last year, you can appoint me remotely, using online technology that forgoes the time-honored enhancement of in-person Kabalas Kinyan. (relying on the Kinyan we have made in previous years)

By submitting the form, you will be appointing me as your agent to sell your Chametz. This will fulfill all of the halachic requirements. Please remember to click on the SUBMIT button at the end of the form to complete the process.


