

**When called by your Hebrew Name come up to the Bimah and stand at the Torah Reader's right.
Touch the Torah with a corner of your Tallit to the place that the reader is pointing
Then kiss that corner of your Tallit
Recite the following Blessings:**

**בְּרַכּוּ אֶת-יְהוָה הַמְּבָרֵךְ
Barkhu et Adonai ha-m'vorakh**

Congregation Responds

**בְּרוּךְ יְהוָה הַמְּבָרֵךְ לְעוֹלָם וָעֶד
Barukh Adnoai ha-m'vorakh l'olam va-ed**

Person reciting blessing repeats

**בְּרוּךְ יְהוָה הַמְּבָרֵךְ לְעוֹלָם וָעֶד
Barukh Adnoai ha-m'vorakh l'olam va-ed**

Person reciting blessing continues

**בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר בָּחַר בָּנוּ
(pause) מִכָּל-הָעַמִּים וְנָתַן לָנוּ אֶת-תּוֹרָתוֹ. בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה
נֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה.**

**Barukh attah Adonai, eloheinu melekh ha-olam, asher bahar banu
mi-kol ha-amim, v'natan lanu et torato. Barukh attah Adonai,
(pause) noten ha-torah.**

After the Reading of the Torah:

Touch the Torah with a corner of your Tallit to the place that the reader is pointing

Then kiss that corner of your Tallit

Recite the following Blessing:

**בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר נָתַן לָנוּ תּוֹרַת
אֱמֶת וְחַיֵּי עוֹלָם נָטַע בְּתוֹכֵנוּ. בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה (pause) נוֹתֵן
הַתּוֹרָה.**

**Barukh attah Adonai, eloheinu melekh ha-olam, asher natan lanu
torat emet, v'hayei olam nata b'tockhenu. Barukh attah Adonai,
(pause) noten ha-torah.**

After you complete the blessing, you should move over to the left side of the Torah Reader and stay there during the next Aliyah.
