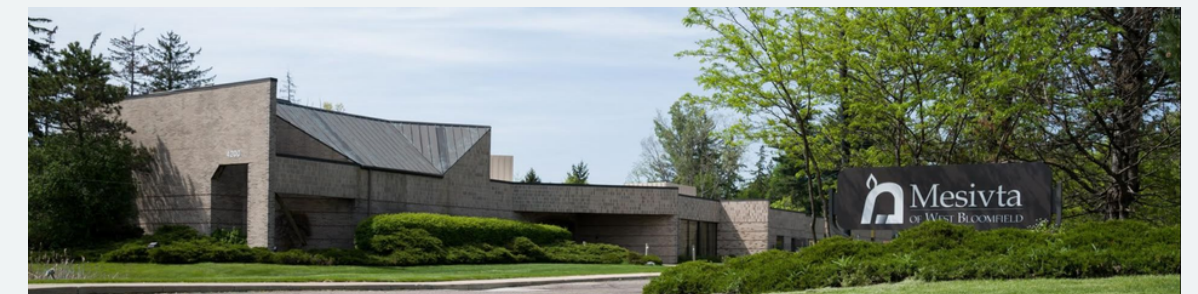

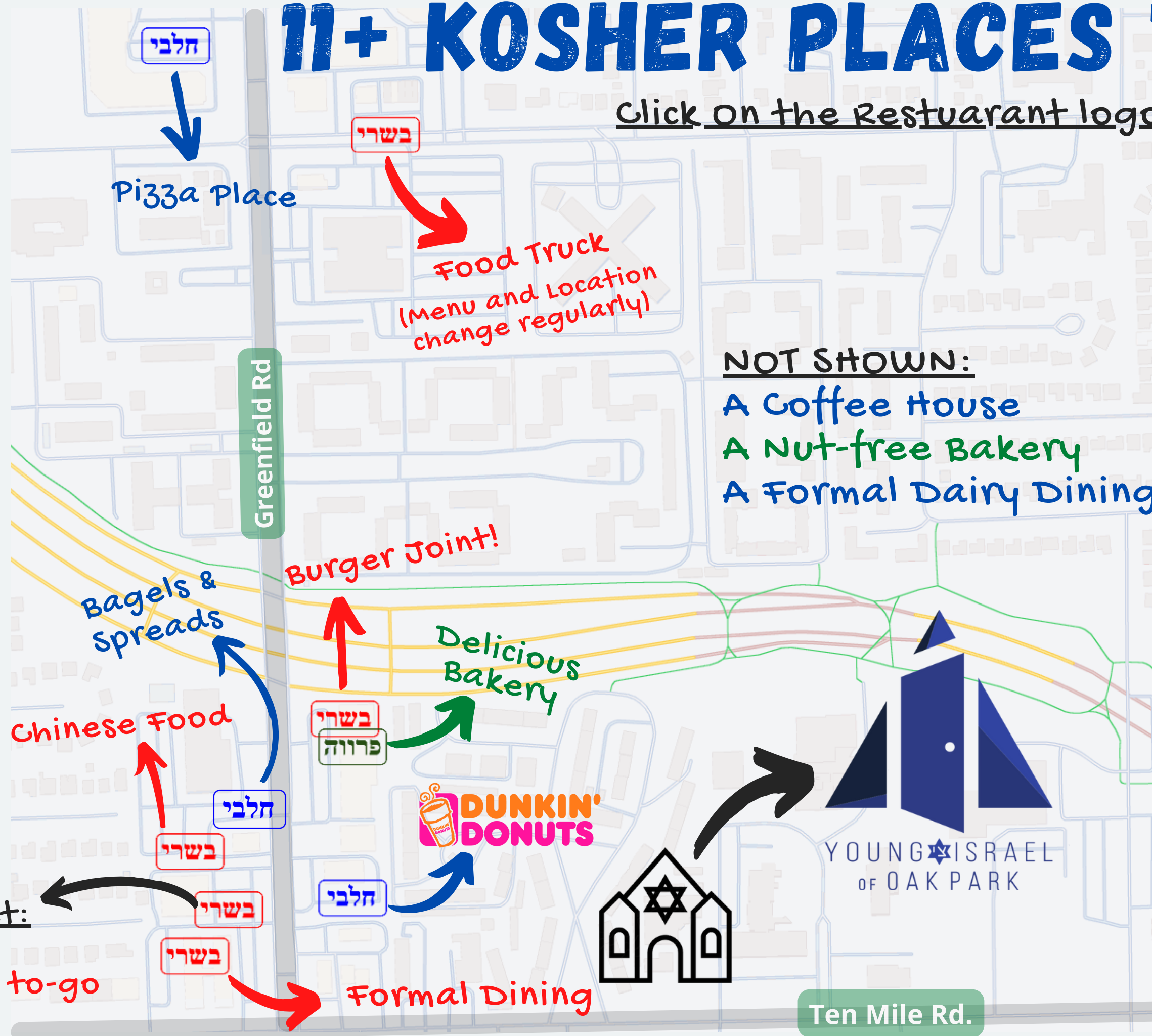

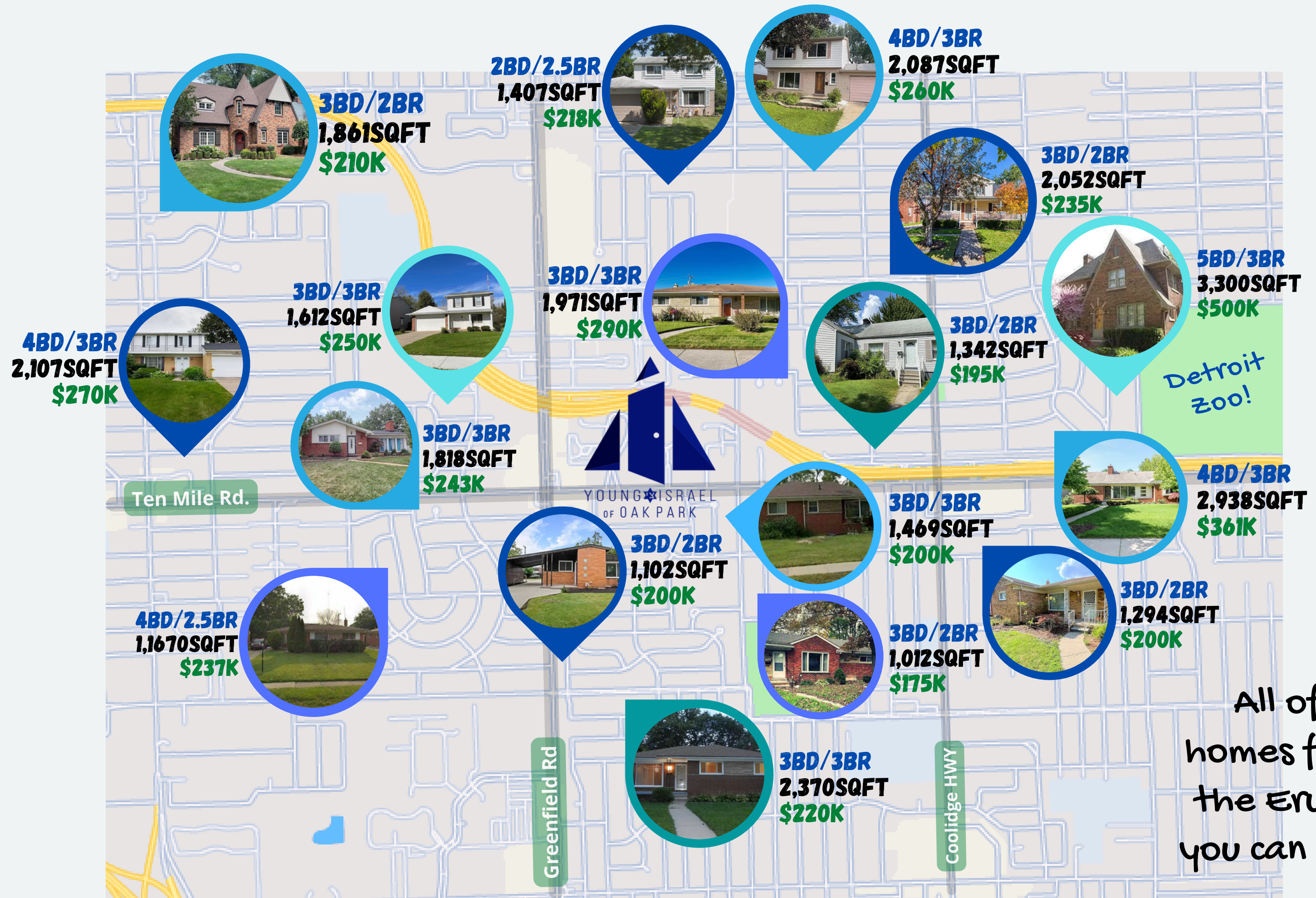

WEATHER



Did you know that Oak Park gets 5 LESS inches of rain per year than the national average? (Compared to 5-10 in. MORE in the Tri-State area)



WORK

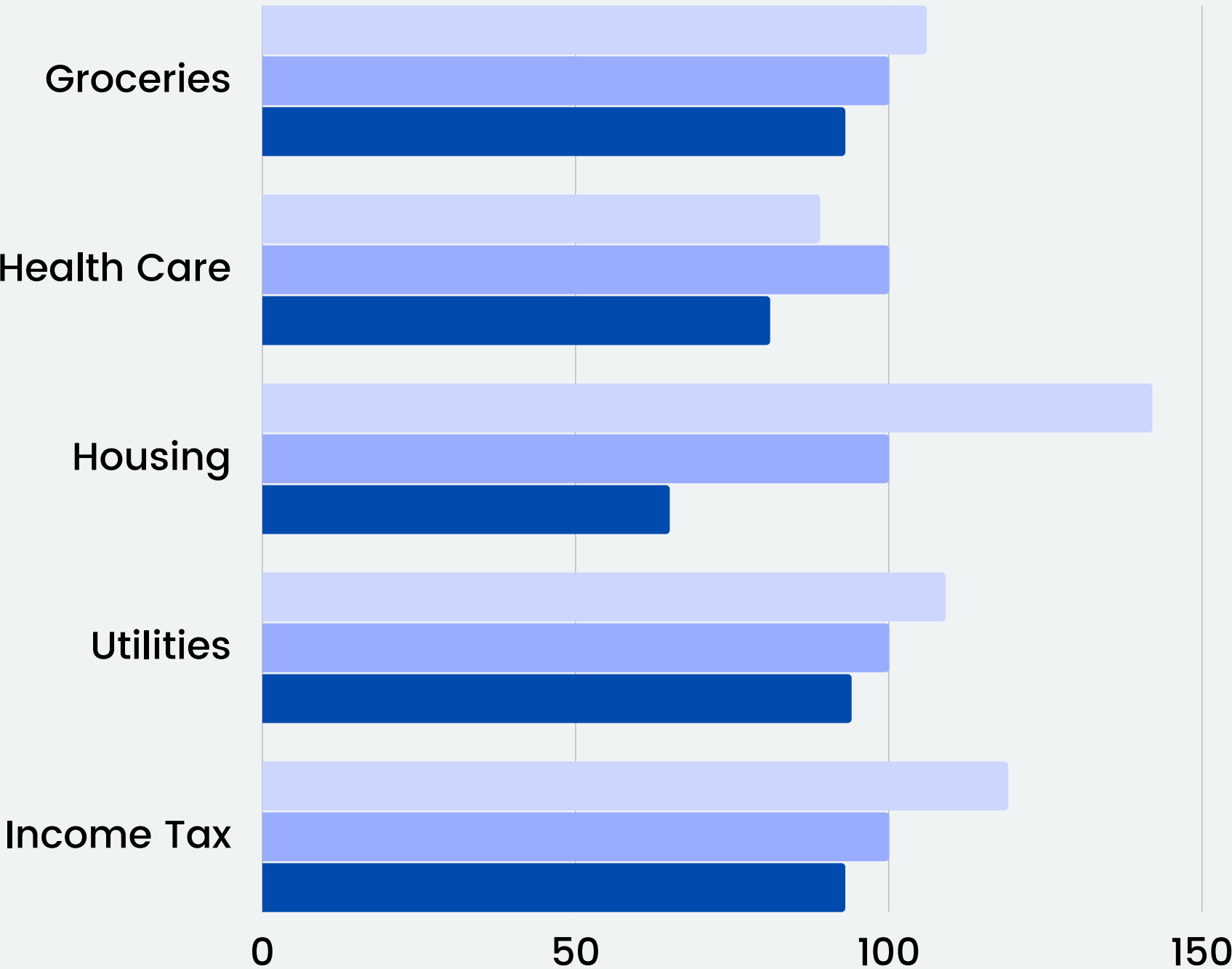
