

# Magen David Reopening Plan – June 2020

MDSC plans to open its doors to congregants and guests with the following guidelines in place:

1. Security personnel at the front door will use an infrared thermometer on visitors entering the premises. If you show signs of a fever you will be asked to leave.
2. Facemasks are required to enter the building and you will be required to keep it on while you're in the sanctuary. Please bring a facemask from home. In case of emergency, disposable facemasks will be provided.
3. We are asking all visitors to wash their hands before entering the sanctuary. Hand sanitizing stations will be available as well.
4. Seating is limited. Please only sit in a seat with a green dot. All other chairs are closed at this time.
5. We will not be sharing siddurim or other items.
6. No food or drinks will be permitted at this time, without prior approval.
7. We are strongly discouraging hugs or shaking hands. Please do not kiss the Torah or any Mezuzot in the building.
8. Those who are older or who have serious underlying medical conditions are strongly encouraged to pray at home and should consult with a medical professional before attending services. If you have shown any signs of COVID or been in contact with someone that has contracted the virus, please do not enter the building at this time.
