AIPAC ISRAEL UPDATE January 11, 2019**U.S. Buys More Israeli Defense Systems to Protect Tanks, APCs**

The U.S. military awarded a nearly \$80 million contract for the purchase of an Israeli-developed missile defense system to protect tanks and armored personnel carriers, after reaching a similar \$200 million deal this past summer, the Rafael Advanced Defense Systems contractor announced Wednesday.

According to [The Times of Israel](#), the United States is expected to pay another \$120 million for more defense systems as part of the agreement, pending final approvals, bringing the total value of the two contracts to approximately \$400 million, according to a spokesperson for the weapons manufacturer. The systems, which block incoming anti-tank missiles and rockets, will be supplied to the U.S. Army by the American defense contractor Leonardo DRS, Inc., which partnered with Rafael to manufacture them. The Trophy, known in Hebrew as Me'il Ruah, or "Windbreaker," is an active defense system manufactured by Rafael that is designed to protect tanks and other armored vehicles from missiles and rockets. The system is made up of a radar detection system that spots incoming missiles and predicts their trajectories, and launchers that fire buckshot-like metal pellets, which cause the incoming missile or rocket to detonate away from the tank.

SECURITY ASSESSMENT FEE

Dear CBH Members,

Rabbi Gross, the Board of Directors and the President want our congregation to know we take the security and safety of our shul members and guests first and foremost. A security assessment to evaluate our facility, security policies, and security procedures has recently been completed. We conferred with the Crime Prevention Unit of Lower Merion Township, individual experts in the field of security as well as discussions and seminars on the subject. New security protocols will be implemented which include new locks, cameras, tighter access to the shul and people monitoring/guarding the shul. We believe this to be a necessary step to help ensure our safety.

In order to cover the additional expenses the Board has voted to impose a Security Assessment Fee of \$150.00/year for each membership. All members will be assessed this fee regardless of the membership level. To be clear: full members (family or single), associate members (family or single), and new members with altered dues structure will be assessed the \$150.00 yearly security fee.

This notice is being sent because we do not want you to receive notice of a \$150.00 charge posted to your account without an explanation. This assessment is a first dollar payment priority. This means any money paid to the shul will go towards this assessment before being applied to any other open charges on your account.

May Hashem watch over our congregation and all of Israel during these challenging times.
