

FINTA BETH HAIM (Funeral Expenses Scheme)

Any person joining the Congregation over the age of 70 will not be entitled to a reduced burial fee, including the single grave supplement and the Hoop Lane levy.

By making a single payment known as Finta Beth Haim, members will be entitled to a reduced funeral charge.

The payment covers husband and wife and children under the age of 19. It is assessed according to the age of the principal member of the Household, as per the table below.

The benefit of this payment, as set out below, is effective as long as paid up membership of the Congregation is maintained.

Where Finta Beth Haim has been paid in a person's lifetime, the current basic charge for a funeral is £1850.

If it has **NOT** been paid, the current basic charge is £3680 Edgwarebury £4200 Hoop Lane.

For non-members, the basic funeral charge is currently £8400 Edgwarebury £8450 Hoop Lane.
