

Kitot Daled–Hey (4th–5th Grade)

Students in these classes attend on Sundays from 9:30am–12:00pm plus an additional class in Hebrew. (See *Hebrew* for additional information.) Those classes are on Sundays from 8:15am–9:30am; or Tuesdays from 4:30pm–6:00pm; or Wednesdays from 4:15pm–5:45pm. The focus of our Hebrew program is reading and understanding the liturgy. During each Hebrew class students will attend a worship service to become familiar with Friday evening and Saturday morning service.

On Sundays the students participate in Chugim, special interest electives, which provide an enrichment approach to the curriculum. The 4th grade focuses on blessings specific to the holidays while 5th grade reviews the holidays by studying the foods associated with them. Fourth grade also focuses on ways to make the world a better place using the lessons of individuals like Martin Luther King, Jr., as an example. Fifth grade explores the Jewish life cycle; each student adopts a Teddy Bear and guides it through the life cycle.
