- Tickets will go in the mail starting August 10th.
- Each member family in good standing will receive two (2) High Holiday tickets.

This has been a very busy month for the farm team as veggies and fruit go from baby plants to full harvesting. Where does all the food go?

Our farm stand is open (typically Tuesdays - watch email for days and times) and the produce could not be fresher. Sweet Grass restaurant in Tarrytown has been a big purchaser of our produce so please be sure and check out their menu. We are continuing our tradition of donating loads of produce to local food banks in Ossining as well.

There are a few people that we need to acknowledge for their super efforts in keeping the farm functioning, productive, clean and safe...

First and foremost, our farm manager, **David Levitt.** He has done an outstanding job managing the various tasks and is an excellent problem solver as new challenges arise. It seems like every other day there is something (large or small) surprising that happens at the farm. His attention to detail and his commitment are obvious when you tour the fields. Bravo David!

John Chambal, who very creatively and quickly moves all of our harvest - either into sales to local restaurants or into yummy recipes of his own - all available for sale at the farm stand. His aesthetic sense allows for an appetizing display of our products and professionally boxed deliveries to the local chefs. This includes beautiful fresh flower arrangements. Excellent!

Westchester Tree Life has been generous over the years helping to keep us safe as we enjoy the farm space under the canopy of mature oak trees. They have supplied us with loads and loads (unlimited) of wood chips and various machinery to split logs and spread the chips - all donated. Thank you to Bill Davies and Co.!!

Aaron Stern and Sons have been attending the grape vines with diligence and detail. They have lately been trying various schemes to net and protect the 2021 batch of ripening grapes from the birds. I know they would welcome some volunteer help, so please reach out to Aaron if you can lend him a hand (typically on Sunday mornings). sternab@aol.com
