CSI Community Organic Farm

Regenerative Agriculture Rooted in Jewish Tradition

We are well into another growing season on our CSI farm. Almost all of us assume that things will go well and as planned. Prepare the soil, make sure that the irrigation system is working, plant the seeds, pull the weeds, tie up the tomato plants, watch everything grow and then reap the rewards.

Unfortunately, things don't always go as planned. The life of a farmer is not an easy one. On *Shavuot*, as my mind wondered a bit during the service, I read the following (*Lev Shalem*, p. 305) *Shavuot* article: "For an agricultural society, the time between planting and harvest is fraught with danger—will the seed invested in the new planting produce an adequate yield, or will it be subject to mold, plagues of insects, or a shortage of water and nutrients?"

We read about the poor harvests that Joseph predicted would impact Egypt. We know about the Irish potato famine and recent news coverage has highlighted the difficulty of moving harvested grain from Ukraine. Until recently, except during times of war, the U.S. citizens have not experienced shortages. That has certainly changed in the past couple of years. Hopefully our food supply will remain intact. We should largely thank our farmers for that, including those who continue to participate on the CSI farm.

I assisted with some of the seed planting several weeks ago. In an effort to produce desired crops throughout the summer, we plant some vegetables as "starters" in the spring and then we plant seeds in small containers, transplanting these to the soil after a few weeks. Here's an example: as you know, our garden is organic; we do not use pesticides on our vegetables. Some varieties of squash (zucchini for example) are subject to attack by borers. This results in the plants dying. Our

hope is that by the time this happens, we will be able to plant the new squash. By this time, the borers will, hopefully, have had their fill and the new crop will proceed unaffected.

I had an observation while I was placing the seeds in the small containers. The difference in seed sizes is truly amazing. Again, using zucchini. as an example, those seeds were about half an inch long. Kohlrabi, another of my plantings, had seeds that looked just like poppy seeds. The size of the seeds is often unrelated to the size of the full-grown vegetable. Why is that?

By now, several varieties of farm fresh vegetables (and chicken eggs) are available for your tasting pleasure. I suggest trying some varieties that may be new to you as well as enjoying old favorites. And of course, consider volunteering on the farm. If you are interested, please contact Ryna Lustig at rynalustig@gmail.com. You may wish to consider planting vegetables that are harvested in the fall.

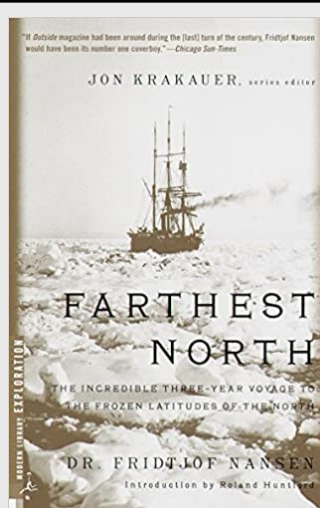

CSI Resettlement Committee Update – Possible Resettlement of Ukrainian Family

It has been an amazing six months for the CSI Resettlement Committee and most importantly for our Afghan family. We have come together as a community to support this young refugee family as they try to build a new life here in America. Thanks to so many of you the K family is thriving! They moved in on February 28th, have had hours of volunteer (and WCC) ESL lessons, had a new baby on April 4th, started a new job, their 2-year-old started attending CSI Summer Camp, and those are just a few of the amazing milestones. In addition, many of us have connected to this family in ways we could never have imagined. As a community we have forever changed the lives of this family and we have been changed in the process.

The United States is no longer air-lifting Afghans out of Kabul but, there are other communities that need our support and compassion. The war in Ukraine has caused millions of Ukrainians to flee Russian aggression. The Biden administration will approve humanitarian parole in the US for up to 100,000 Ukrainians for up to two years under the “Uniting for Ukraine” program. **With the help of HIAS, WJCI, Open Arms for Refugees and you, CSI can welcome a Ukrainian family.**

Please join us on August 4th at 7pm at CSI or on Zoom to learn more about what would be involved in resettling a Ukrainian family. In many ways the work will be like the work we’ve done with the K family, and in some ways it will be simpler (possibly less ESL, familiarity with shopping, etc.). We are not a committee of experts but a committee of dedicated volunteers helping in large and small ways.

We are looking for some new volunteers who would like to get involved with a Ukrainian family.
