


#### **OUR MISSION STATEMENT**

### ATTENDING HIGH HOLIDAY SERVICES

- Tickets will go in the mail starting September 5th.
- Each dual member family in good standing will receive two (2) High Holiday tickets. Children do not need tickets.
- A single member in good standing will receive one (1) High Holiday ticket. Children do not need tickets.
- A member in good standing is someone who has no outstanding balance from a prior year and has paid at least 1/3 of their current balance (membership, security, building fund) by September 1st.
- Please adhere to all security policies! They have been put into place to provide a safe and comfortable High Holiday experience for everyone. We cannot stress enough how important this is.
- Tickets are required for entry for all those over age 25. Ticket holders' names will be on the back of each ticket.

Help create and memorialize CSI's unique and invaluable collective history!


### Suggested but not limited to:
