We, the undersigned, of full age, citizens of the
 United States, all of whom are citizens of the
 State of New York and resident therein, being desirous of associating
 ourselves together for benevolent, charitable
 and social purposes

, as
 hereinafter is more particularly described, pursuant to and in conformity
 with an Act of the Legislature of the State of New York, passed April 12th,
 1848, entitled "An Act for the Incorporation of Benevolent, Charitable,
 Scientific and Missionary Societies," and the several Acts of the said
 Legislature amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify
 and declare as follows:

First.

That the corporate name by which said Society
 hereby to be formed shall be known and distinguished is and shall be
The Society of the Sons of Israel

Second.

That the objects for which said Society is
 formed are as follows, viz.: To assist each other
 in distress sickness and death
 and to foster and promote fraternal
 and social feelings among the
 members thereof

Third.

That the number of Trustees of said
Society shall be and are five in number; and
that the names and residences of such Trustees who shall
manage its concerns for the first year are as follows:

Abraham Feinberg, Harry Macy
Abraham Altman and Michael
Azams, all of whom severally
reside in the Village of Sing Sing
County of Westchester and State of
New York.

Fourth.

That the principal Office of said
Society shall be and is located in the Village
of Sing Sing County of Westchester and State of New York.
