Good Standing Policy:

A congregant is considered in Good Financial Standing when either:

- all of the following are met by the congregant:
 - o all prior years' payments are paid in full
 - o Current Dues, Fees, and Assessments:
 - 1/3 paid by September 1st of the current fiscal year

(Approved: 8/22/2023)

- 2/3 paid by December 1st of the current fiscal year
- fully paid by March 1st of the current fiscal year
- Current High Holiday Tickets/Parking are fully paid by December 1st of current fiscal year
- Religious School Tuition:
 - 1/2 paid by September 1st of the current fiscal year
 - fully paid by December 1st of the current fiscal year
- Camp fees are paid by June 15 of the prior fiscal year.
- Nursery School Tuition:
 - 1/3 of total paid by April 30 of prior fiscal year
 - 2/3 of total paid by June 30 of prior fiscal year
 - fully paid by August 31 of current fiscal prior (prior to start of school)

OR

 the congregant is current on a payment plan with the Synagogue and such plan is scheduled to be fully paid prior to the end of the current fiscal year.

For the June annual Congregational Meeting, all open charges for the current or prior years should be paid, though recent minor charges may be ignored if all other conditions are met.

A member may cure a loss of Good Financial Standing by satisfying the above requirements for Good Financial Standing, or, under special circumstances, at the approval of both the Treasurer and President.

A member in Good Financial Standing shall be considered a Member in Good Standing unless, as determined by the Board of Trustees and in accordance with the Synagogue Constitution, the member fails to fulfill the requirements of membership, or the member brings discredit upon the Congregation.
