



COVID-19 EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR JEWISH EDUCATION GUIDELINES

The Jewish Federation of Omaha has recognized that many families have been financially impacted by COVID-19. Perhaps you or your partner have lost a job or had your salary reduced. Through the JFO's COVID-19 Emergency Relief Fund, we continue to raise funds through a community campaign to help these families with household expenses – rent or mortgage payments, utilities, or groceries.

The JFO has now extended this support to include tuition for Jewish Education. A second scholarship process has been opened specifically for families financially impacted by COVID-19 with children enrolled in either the Pennie Z. Davis Early Childhood Education Center or the Friedel Jewish Academy.

The Jewish Federation of Omaha's Financial Aid Committee will convene as needed to review applications and determine awards. JFO's FAC is an anonymous committee charged with administering the allocation and distribution of scholarship and financial assistance funds entrusted to the community for the benefit of Jewish Omaha.

In addition to the completed application, we are asking for proof of the financial impact COVID-19 has caused your family. For example, this could be a communication from your employer or the government or copies of before and after paystubs.
