

Surrounded by a beautifully landscaped garden, *Derech Hashalom* is the perfect setting for quiet reflection and relaxation. The path features comfortable benches covered with shady arbors leading up to a hexagonal shaped centerpiece featuring a Star of David made from natural blue stone. The hexagonal shape is in keeping with the historical design of our building. The colorful flowers, shrubs and trees make it the ideal place to find serenity before or after services, or for that matter, whenever you need a moment of peace.

With *Derech Hashalom* scheduled to be completed by this summer, brick pavers are now available for purchase and may be inscribed with your personalized message to memorialize and/or honor family and friends or simply inscribe your family name. It's the perfect way to celebrate the birth of a grandchild, a Bar/Bat Mitzvah, a wedding, an anniversary, mark any special occasion or no occasion at all.


