Three years ago, my bulletin article posed the question, 'what will we learn about ourselves when we emerge from the pandemic?" While COVID is here to stay,

we have certainly emerged from where we were in spring of 2020. So what did I learn?

I learned how much I need to be with actual people. I don't mind video conferencing. It's a wonderful tool when necessary. It allows people to stay connected. It allowed families across the country to mourn loved ones together. Our family had incredibly meaningful Shivah gatherings for my brother, Ken, over Zoom. They were, perhaps even more meaningful than if they had been in person.

But I learned that, eventually, I was much healthier, and a bit less anxious, if I stayed off of social media and Zoom classes and focused on seeing people in person. I know this is not possible for everyone and I'm so glad we have the technology that can keep people engaged in community and learning over video. Perhaps, as a musician, the practical need to be in the same room with people to make music factored into the equation of what I needed. I never liked the choirs with everyone spliced together into a video and I liked it even less when it was a necessity. It is such a gift to be able to sing with people in person and play music with others in real time.

Our Shabbat morning services and daily Minyanim are affirmations of life. Our monthly Shabbat Song Circles are celebrations of beauty and healing. The sound of 15-30 voices swirling around the air in the Mendelson Family Library, restores my soul. Last time we met, we shared our thoughts about a selection of a passage by Shalom Noah Berzovsky from our beautiful Siddur Lev Shalem.

"On Shabbat, we enter this world of gentleness, of appreciation, of welcome. We join in community . . . of people finding each other."

It is so healing to find one another; to just sit and be, in song and in silence, in prayer and in laughter. After emerging, I seek out these opportunities even more than before. I am more aware of what is healthy for me and what is not.

While this article is coming out after the final Shabbat Song Circle of the season, I look forward to Shabbat Zimrah on June 10. Like Shabbat Shirah, we will have a nosh at 8:30 am and then a beautiful service filled with opportunities for song and for silence. What a wonderful opportunity to find each other once again.

The Meyer Kranzberg Learning Center



My grandmother died two years ago. She was the last of my grandparents. Each of them left an indelible mark on my life. From each of them, in their

own way, I learned so much. Through stories shared and experiences I had with each of them, I began to hear about their lives "before" I even existed. Their accomplishments. Their impact. Their choices. Their values.

When I first came to B'nai Amoona, I was informed that the Religious School was named MKLC. Only after my first week did I learn what those initials meant. The Meyer Kranzberg Learning Center. Upon hearing this I asked the question, "Who is/was Meyer Kranzberg?" I was not raised at B'nai Amoona and the name Kranzberg to me brought to mind philanthropy in the community. It was associated with Federation, the Day School, and the Art Community in the St. Louis Community.

Once I asked the question, my lessons began! In St. Louis the name Kranzberg is often associated with giving. With righteous acts. With the understanding that it is important to do the work and support that which is good for the community. I also learned that the Kranzberg family was multi-generational. The Meyer Kranzberg of MKLC was a man with great knowledge. He was a charismatic person. He was a man who understood the importance of

the Jewish Community and Synagogue life. He was also a man with - what my grandmother would call - a bit of chutzpah!

Were it not for Meyer Kranzberg, I am confident that B'nai Amoona and our Kehillah, our community, would not exist. Mr. Kranzberg was the Vice President of B'nai Amoona when the decision was made to buy land and begin the move of B'nai Amoona to Trinity. He was the chairman of the Capital Campaign, and without his leadership and belief in this move, it may never have occurred. Ken Kranzberg, Meyer's son, delayed his Bar Mitzvah by one month so as to be the first Bar Mitzvah in Trinity's Sanctuary.

Once my listening campaign began, it was apparent that there was much more to his life at the Synagogue. His Presidency was from 1951 to 1955. During those years many important decisions were made for the Congregation. Mr. Kranzberg was responsible for ensuring that a President's term had limits. His tenure included a time when the Executive Director demanded a raise just before the High Holidays, and threatened to leave if it was not granted. Mr. Kranzberg was a man of integrity and did not like this threatening behavior. He did not grant the raise, and the Executive Director left immediately. This left Mr. Kranzberg with the responsibility of ensuring that the High Holy Days went off without a hitch. When the Cantor no

longer wanted to be the one opening the synagogue for business every day, Mr Kranzberg told him to give him the keys and someone else would replace his job! This convinced the Cantor to continue his responsibilities until he retired. He was also the one who hired Burt Grossman as well as brought Ted Fisher into the synagogue to soon assume a leadership position. One of the greatest triumphs of all was when Mr. Meyer Kranzberg went to Chicago and convinced our beloved Rabbi Lipnick (z"l), that we needed him in St. Louis and that he must come back to B'nai Amoona. When Mr Kranzberg talked, the great Rabbi listened and returned.

Meyer Kranzberg and his legacy is felt throughout our community. He was a man who was easy going until he saw injustices and then he became strong willed in his fight and ideals. His life was one of sacrifice, determination, hope, and persistence. He said what he was going to do, and then followed through. This was his life until he died on his 72nd Birthday.

For all this, and so much more, Kenneth Kranzberg, Meyer Kranzberg's son, wanted to dedicate a valuable entity of B'nai Amoona to his father. This is why we are all able to learn, grow, and benefit from the Meyer Kranzberg Learning Center at B'nai Amoona. May his life continue to bless us with a love of Jewish learning and joy. May we recognize, L'dor V'Dor, the generations that came before and may



we continue to remember them in our hearts and minds. May we continue to learn from our parents, grandparents, and great grandparents. Without our foremothers and forefathers, without Sarah, Rebecca, Rachel and Leah or Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the Jewish community that embraces us today would not exist.

May we learn from Ken Kranzberg that it is important for each of us to remember the gifts of those who came before us and find ways to keep the memories of their parents alive. To Meyer Kranzberg I will continue to say thank you!

The Art Gallery at Binai Amoona

The Art Gallery at B'nai Amoona is concluding its first season which has been exceedingly successful. There were 13 artists represented. We began with our own Obbie Price (z"l) whose watercolors were a real delight and a hit with our congregation and all of those who saw them. The other artists that have been represented this first season were Gary Kodner, Mark Witzling, Tsila Schwartz, Mark Koritz, Lenore Pepper, Jill Nassau, Jonathan Levy, Dganit Moreno, Bob Denlow, David Capes, Neshama Roash, and Sandy Kaplan. Our preschool artists exhibited during the Hanukkah season

and the fourth-grade students at the SMJCS exhibited their remarkable art as well.

Our most recent artist reception attracted more than one hundred people, most of whom were not B'nai Amoona members, thus giving B'nai Amoona a presence in the community that it might not otherwise have.

The cost of the art hanging systems, enhanced lighting installations, reception expenses, and publicity have amounted to several thousand dollars, all of which was funded by donations and art sales. There has been no cost to the operating budget.

The art committee, composed of Carole Simon, a long-time docent of the St. Louis Art Museum, Sandy Kaplan, a prominent ceramic sculptor, Rachel Bray Spezia, a graphic artist, Jan Baron, and Lester Goldman are greatly indebted to Jeff Singer for his vision and support, and also to our professional office staff, Anita Kraus, Gail Armstrong, and Vickie Shuchart. We are also much indebted to Beth Saltzman who, with Chris Whitaker, provided the sumptuous reception buffets and Karen Noss, who enhanced our receptions with her beautiful harp playing. The committee is very thankful

for the help of Norwood Janitorial Services who assisted our artists in installing their art for each exhibit.

Our current exhibit of fine art photographs and ceramic sculptures will conclude on June 9th. This summer the children artists of Ramot Amoona and B'nai Ami will be displaying their work. The committee is already hard at work planning our next season of exhibits.




