

## YINN EILAT TRIP NOVEMBER 2024

Having investigated many possibilities for the Shul Eilat trip in November 2024, including those of ½ board, we have come to the following conclusion.

1. Prices for November have increased considerably everywhere.
2. The Laguna is unavailable as they have no free rooms with walk-in showers during the cheaper period in November.
3. We considered hotels with ½ board, but that would mean you would be charged extra for every tea/coffee/cold drink/ ice cream /afternoon tea etc and the price would work out considerably more expensive overall.
4. We looked at the Sport Hotel, a larger hotel, run on exactly the same lines as the Laguna with the same head chef, larger island in the dining room where the food is cooked in front of you, 3 pools, more comfortable seating everywhere and more choice of rooms with all the walk-in showers we would require.. Although we have been coming to the Laguna for some 25 years or so and cannot fault the Hotel and Staff in any way, we feel it unfair and against the whole principle of the holiday, to have to exclude many of our congregation who need the facility of a walk-in shower. The Manager of the Sport knows us as he was previously the Manager of the Laguna.

We have therefore decided to reserve the Sport for the period of 17<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> November 2024
