All-inclusive tuition includes transportation (chaperoned walk) from Lawrence, Pierce, or Coolidge Corner Schools (FRR) for kindergarten students.

HomeBASE follows the Public Schools of Brookline (PSB) calendar. * Assumes one early release day per week (TBD by PSB), approximately 15 hours a week.

Sibling Discount: Each additional child is entitled to 10% off total tuition up to \$400

Additional Offerings:

Early Release Care: Included in monthly tuition, students will be picked up at the appropriate time and transitioned to HomeBASE/ARS.

ARS Transition: ARS Transition is available to HomeBASE students at no extra charge. On these days, your student will be transitioned from Lawrence, Pierce, or Coolidge Corner/FRR Schools and join us for some active play before being transitioned into their ARS class.

Registration

- Families can register for five (5) days a week. For those children attending ARS there is a four (4) days a week option (no Tuesday). Group size will be limited per DEEC policy (currently 12 children/group). As such we will need a minimum of six (6) children in each group.
- In order to complete your child's registration, a non-refundable flat rate deposit (\$500) is due with your application. This deposit is a partial payment for your September payment.



HomeBASE Enrollment & Registration Procedures

Financial

Tuition is paid based on a ten (10) month annualized rate. We have already taken holidays and planned vacation time into account. For ease of payment, the annualized rate is broken into 10 equal payments, with the first two payments (deposit payment) due upon enrollment.

A \$500 deposit for each child is due upon enrollment. Payments can be made via check (made payable to Temple Ohabei Shalom) or through your ShulCloud account. An invoice will be sent to you via email. The remainder of your deposit (equal to two months tuition, first and last month) is due by June 1, 2021.

Eight (8) monthly payments are due (October through May), payments are due the 1st of the month. Families will be invoiced monthly on the 15th of each month. Payments received after the 10th of each month are assessed a \$25 late fee. Families are responsible for any fees associated with checks returned for insufficient funds plus a \$25 handling/processing fee.

Those who choose to withdraw after the start of the school year and before March 1, 2022, must give thirty (30) days written notice to the Program Director and their tuition deposit payment will be applied to the child's final month of attendance. Families who choose to withdraw after March 1, 2022 are required to pay for the school year in full.

Tuition adjustments or refunds will not be made if a child misses school due to illness, vacation, or otherwise, and will not be made if HomeBASE is closed because of weather or governmental orders related to public safety (except as noted in the financial policies below).

All-inclusive tuition includes transportation (chaperoned walk) from Lawrence, Peirce, or Coolidge Corner Schools (FRR).

FINANCIAL POLICIES IN THE EVENT OF A CLOSURE DUE TO COVID-19:

If HomeBASE is required to close one or multiple classrooms due to COVID-19 (see illness policy) and/or there is a state or town mandated closure, there will be no refunds given for the first two weeks (10 school days) of closure. If any classrooms must stay closed longer than ten (10) school days, families of children in that class will be refunded for each scheduled school day's tuition paid at a prorated rate until we can re-open; however, we will retain your deposit payment throughout the school year. If/when we return to school during the 20-21 school year, you will be responsible to pay your tuition effective the first day of reopening, regardless of whether or not you choose to send your child. In the case of multiple classroom closures during the 20-21 school year, families will be required to pay 75% of their tuition for the first 10 school days (or less) of closure for each subsequent occurrence.
