

TBE to host Jewish Artist-In-Residence, Ellen Alt

As part of Temple Beth El's Jewish family education program, we are excited and honored to host the Jewish educator and artist Ellen Alt. Ellen's work has been exhibited in the U.S., Germany, Russia, China, England, and the Middle East. One of her art pieces is part of the collection at The White House, in Washington, D.C. Among

Ellen's primary interests is the area of "Community Art," which aims to bring people together to create art as a cooperative group. Community art strengthens the community by improving relationships between groups of people.

The planning for the "Community Art" project that Ellen will be directing began this past fall and will be implemented this coming spring. The project is



called the "Middot Garden." "Middot" is the Hebrew term for "inner traits" common to all humans, such as responsibility, honor, compassion, love, etc. The project will bring together families from our E. G. Scoblionko Religious School, TBE Board of Directors, Lehigh Valley Jewish teens and various community Jewish organizations to teach about Jewish values related to the earth and respectful human behavior. One of the goals is to promote the creativity of learners of all ages by allowing them to express themselves visually through learning about Jewish values. The planning and execution of the project will take place at Temple Beth El. When the project is completed, the colorful mural will be displayed on the new vinyl-fenced play area on the grounds of TBE.

We are extremely excited about this project and invite you to take part in the project. In the next months, you will have an opportunity to sign up.


Welcome

The Classes will run on an 8-week session.




