

The C.D.C. now recommends that everyone in areas of substantial or high risk transmission rates, regardless of vaccination status, wear masks indoors in public places. Nearly all counties across the United States are experiencing either “substantial” or “high” transmission rates that would fall under the C.D.C. recommendation.

Not only is Pike County considered a "substantial risk" County, we also have just learned of 2 positive tests in HF this week, apparently related to an indoor event at one of the other houses of worship.

Therefore, effective immediately, after consultation with our medical/ science advisory committee, JFHF is changing its Covid protocol. MASKS ARE NOW REQUIRED to be worn and worn properly covering nose and mouth THROUGHOUT THE FELLOWSHIP AT ALL TIMES. This includes Entry Foyer, Social Hall, Office, Kitchen, Restrooms, and Sanctuary, REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS.

JFHF is making this change in an abundance of caution for the sake of the HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ALL.
