PARSHA MATTERS - by Rabbi Sammy Bergman

HEALING FROM ADVERSITY

How do we respond to adversity? What do we do when life disappoints us deeply? To succeed and excel we ought to continuously sharpen our approaches to facing the real and difficult challenges we often encounter.

The recovery process for the *metzora*, a person stricken with affliction known as *tzaraat*, may help to provide perspective. Vayikra 14:3 reads:

וַיַצַאֹ הַכֹּהֵוֹ אֱל־מַחוּץ לַמַּחָנָה וְרָאָהֹ הַכֹּהֵוֹ וְהָנַה נַרְפָּא נַגַע־הַצַּרְעַת מִוֹ־הַצַּרְוּעַ:

The Kohen shall go forth from the camp and Kohen will investigate and behold the tzaraat affliction has been healed from the person who was afflicted.

The Torah's language: "the affliction has been healed from the afflicted" seems both repetitive and backwards. The pasuk would have read much more smoothly if it had said "והנה נרפא הצרוע"," meaning the Kohen will find that the formerly afflicted person has been healed. Why does the Torah describe the healing of *tzaraat* in this strange way?

The Kli Yakar suggests a creative answer. The term *nega tzaraat* refers not to the physical skin affliction of *tzaraat*, but rather to the sinful behaviour which caused the affliction. The external skin defect reflects an internal moral flaw present within the person. Hashem afflicts a person with *tzaraat* to show them the negative impact of their character flaws in a tangible way. During the period in which a *metzora* separates himself from the community due to his impurity, he must ask: what character flaws within me brought upon me this miserable impurity and circumstance? How can I work to improve in these areas? Hence the Kli Yakar argues that the Torah states:

נרפא נגע צרעת מן הצרוע, the *nega*, the spiritual cause of the affliction was healed מן הצרוע, from the person's challenging experience as *metzora*. Had the person never been exposed to their own flaws they never would have gone through the necessary growth process which helped them to improve.

Similarly, we might take inspiration from the healed *metzora* to help engage our adverse challenges. Whether our circumstances were caused by our own flaws like the *metzora*, or they simply result from misfortune that we could not control, we choose how we react. We can look at adversity as an opportunity to work on weaknesses we might not otherwise have addressed, and harness talents we might not otherwise have accessed. The unpleasantness of a difficult challenge can serve as the springboard for an internal growth process which yields both a better result and the satisfaction of realizing our potential.

May Hashem bless each of us with the strength, resilience, and wisdom to transform every difficult challenge we face into a meaningful, curative growth experience.
