PARSHA MATTERS - by Rabbi Jared Anstandig

APPRECIATE THE FLOWERS, NOT ONLY THE FRUIT

Following the Korach rebellion's fiery end, God has the people perform a simple experiment. To demonstrate that God chose the Kohanim to serve before Him, He has leaders of all the tribes leave their staff in the Holy of Holies. Whichever staff buds and flowers, the owner is the one chosen to serve God in this elevated way in the Mishkan (see Bamidbar 16:20).

And so, the Torah describes that twelve staffs were collected, each one from a different tribal leader with his name engraved upon it, and placed in the Ohel Moed. The Torah continues, "It happened on the next day that Moshe went into the Tent of Testimony; and behold, the staff of Aharon for the house of Levi had budded, and put forth buds, and produced blossoms, and bore ripe almonds" (Bamidbar 17:23). Overnight, Aharon's staff, and his staff alone, produced buds, flowers, and fruit. The entire people of Israel now stood witness to the miraculous development of the staff, thereby demonstrating, beyond any doubt, that indeed Aharon and his tribe have a special status.

The classical commentators analyze this experiment: Why prove this with a miraculous staff? Why fruit? And why almonds of all fruits? Knowing that the Torah provides timeless wisdom for all generations, these commentators explain that this event contains a message for our time, just as much as it did for the generation in the desert.

Rav Moshe Feinstein, in Derash Moshe (Bamidbar 17:23), for instance, raises the following question in particular: The Torah presents Aharon's staff as containing buds, flowers, and almonds all together (indeed, the Gemara in Yoma 52b explains that the flowers and almonds became a permanent fixture on the staff). But, botanically speaking, the flowers are gone by the time the almonds grow (go to http://tiny.cc/ssalmonds to watch a video of this). Granted that this entire event is miraculous, but still we ask, what is the message we can take from the fact that the staff contained flowers and almonds at the same time?

Rav Moshe provides a beautiful answer which relates to our personal religious and spiritual lives. He writes, that like the staff, "the flowers of our holiness never whither and fall off." He proceeds to explain that our "fruits" are the mitzvot that we perform; the flowers are everything that we put into performing those mitzvot. Our mundane lives reflect the typical lifecycle of the almond – flowers produce the fruit and then they fall off. We invest our time and energy to produce results, and once our goal is achieved, the work we did is gone. And that's generally okay since all we really ever wanted was the result anyway.

Not so when it comes to our spiritual lives. Yes, we work hard to achieve our religious goals. But our objective is not only the fruit at the end. We also reap reward for the flowers, for the effort that we exert in achieving our spiritual goals. In this domain, the almonds exists alongside the flowers.


This is why Aharon's staff contained both the flowers and the fruit, against the nature of almonds. To demonstrate that our avodat Hashem is not only results-focused. It's not just about the fruit, but it's about the flowers we produce working toward that.


May we reap much fruit in our spiritual lives, and appreciate and benefit the flowers that remain alongside them.


