PARSHA MATTERS by RABBI ANSTANDIG

FIGHT FOR IT!

Through Parashat Yitro we get a good glimpse into Bnei Yisrael's side of the transaction when the Torah was given. What was happening in heaven, however, is a mystery. For this we have the aggadic portions of the Talmud – those passages that, instead of teaching halacha, tell a story. But make no mistake, these stories enlighten just as much as the halachic portions.

Masechet Shabbat 88b is one of those locations that offers insight into what was occurring in heaven prior to Moshe descending with the tablets. Rabbi Yehoshua ben Levi explains that instead of celebrating, the celestial angels were quite irked.

When Moses ascended on High to receive the Torah, the ministering angels said before the Holy One, Blessed be He: Master of the Universe, what is one born of a woman doing here among us? The Holy One, Blessed be He, said to them: He came to receive the Torah. The angels said before Him: The Torah is a hidden treasure that was concealed by you 974 generations before the creation of the world, and you seek to give it to flesh and blood?

The Torah is God's holiest possession. How could He give it to mere mortals?! Curiously, instead of answering their challenge Himself, God turns to Moshe to answer. This is strange. The angels are challenging God; why does He pivot to Moshe?

Perhaps by forcing Moshe to respond He teaches him a valuable lesson. Moshe, having been chosen by God to ascend the mountain to receive the Torah, may see himself in a passive role. God teaches Torah and Moshe simply receives it. By forcing Moshe to argue with the angels, Hashem communicates to Moshe that he must fight for it if he want it.

Pirkei Avot (2:12) quotes Rabbi Yosi who notes that the Torah is not ours simply by inheritance. It doesn't just automatically become ours. Hashem has Moshe alone respond so that he, and we, would understand this message. We cannot wait passively for Torah to come to us. If we want it, we must fight for it.

May we succeed in proactively seeking Torah out, and may we, like Moshe be successful in our achievement of it.

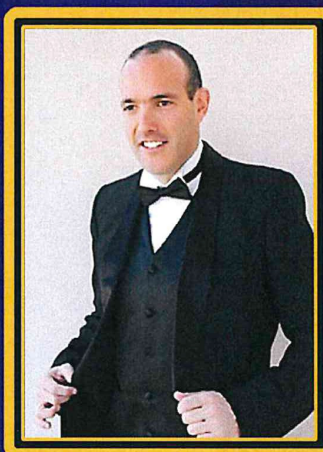

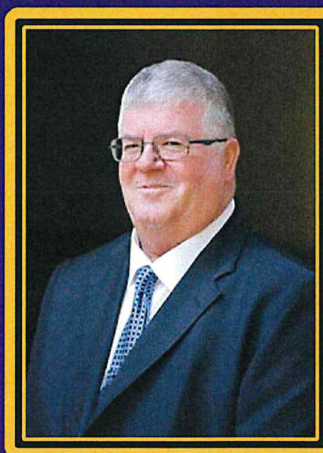
